About sizes

- Dinosaurs have been considered the biggest living things but in fact, the blue whale is bigger than any dinosaur at 108 feet
- The smallest dinosaurs that we know of were just 4-feet and weighed less than a chihuahua (吉娃娃).
- A newborn human baby has a bigger brain than most adult dinosaurs had.



About names

- The word “dinosaurs” belongs to the ancient Greek and means “terrible lizard”. That’s not a nice way to call someone, by the way.
- The fossil of the dino with the longest name was found in China. Its name is: Micropachycephalosaurus. Try pronouncing this one.
- Not everything with “saur” was dinosaurs, like flying pterosaurs weren’t dinosaurs at all!



About dinosaur babies

- The smallest dinosaur egg ever found was only 3 centimeters long and weighed 75 grams.
- The largest dinosaur eggs were around 19 inches long.
- Most dinosaurs’ eggs were just the size of a basketball.



Others

- Most dinosaurs can be known about by just looking at their bone or tooth.
- The modern relative of T. Rex is Chicken! We are eating “dinosaurs”.
- Some scientists, based on bone evidence, have found out that many dinosaurs lived up to 70—30 years!
- Dinosaurs existed everywhere, even in Antarctica.
