Have you ever been to Disneyland?

Disneyland is an amusement park, but we can also *call it* (主题公园) *park*. It has all the normal (有吸引力的事物(或人)) that you can find at an amusement park, but it also had a theme. The theme, of course, is Disney movies and Disney characters. For example, you can find a (过山车) *roller coaster* in most amusement parks, but in Disneyland, the roller coaster is themed with Disney characters.

This means that you can find Disney characters all over the roller coaster. You can also watch Disney movies, eat in Disney restaurants, and buy Disney gifts. And you can *see* **D** *see sb. doing sth.* 看见某人做某事 **and** Disneyland all the time!

Have you ever heard of a Disney **巡游; 巡航** These are huge **小船** that also have the Disney theme. You can *take* **兜风** *de* on the boat for several days, and you can sleep and eat *on* **board.** **on board** 在船(或车、飞机)上

There are also many attractions on board, just like any other Disneyland. You can shop, go to Disney parties, and eat dinner with Mickey Mouse! The boat rides all take different **路线** s, but they all *e* **结束** *p* in the same place. That is Disney's own **岛; 岛屿**

It is just so much fun in Disneyland!
