

2023 is the Year of the Rabbit! Rabbits are quiet, smart and agile (敏捷的). Many Chinese sayings describe these characters. For example, people often say dongruo tuotu (动若脱兔) to praise people for their quick moves. Jiaotu sankou (狡兔三窟) means that a canny rabbit always has many holes. This makes it hard for people to find it.

In Chinese culture, the rabbit is seen as a good sign, because rabbits can have a lot of babies in a short time. Chinese people believed having more children could bring them good

luck and happiness. In Beijing, Lord Rabbit (兔爷) is quite famous. It wears armor (盔甲) with a flag on its back. According to Beijing folk stories, many people got sick in Beijing. The sickness spread quickly from house to house. Lord Rabbit rode on a horse, a tiger or a lion and traveled in the city to save sick people. The people of Beijing were so thankful that they made clay arts of Lord Rabbit. On the Mid-Autumn Festival, people like to put a clay Lord Rabbit in their homes. They hope it can bring health and good luck.

Western people also see the rabbit as a sign of good luck. They believe a rabbit's foot can bring good luck to its owner. This may go back to an old tradition. If teenage hunters caught a rabbit, they could touch its foot. Even adults like to play the game.

There is a long history of tea culture in China. Along with firewood, rice, oil, salt, sauce and vinegar (醋), tea is considered as one of the seven necessities for life in China. Since ancient times, Chinese people have been planting, picking, making and drinking tea.

Boiling tea is one of the oldest Chinese tea brewing methods (煮沏法), dating back to the Tang Dynasty (618—907). Tea leaves were boiled for a long time and sometimes they were cooked together with different kinds of fruits. During this process, people can enjoy a quiet time. Later in the Ming Dynasty (1368—1644), a faster and more convenient method became more popular—steeping (冲泡).

However, the old method is now getting popular among Chinese young people. On the app Xiaohongshu, or Little Red Book, there are over 40,000 posts (帖子) on the topic of “stove-boiled” tea (围炉煮茶). People lightly roast (烤) tea leaves before boiling them in a teapot on a charcoal-filled (装满木炭的) stove. They sit around the stove and have snacks with their hot tea. Some also wear traditional clothes as if it could take them back to those ancient times.

Through “stove-boiled” tea, people can taste a slower, country life and find a little peace. As someone wrote, “It is very relaxing to drink hot tea, feel the soft wind, and chat with best friends.”

As the weather gets warmer, there are few things that are better to do than travel. But traveling might not be fun for everyone, especially for those who have motion sickness (晕动症). 51 People with motion sickness feel very uncomfortable while they are taking a bus, a train or a ship. 52 Some people even throw up (呕吐). believed that motion sickness happens when the senses become unclear.
