- Nicholas Winton, born on 19 May 1909 in London, once worked in banks in Germany and France after school and returned to Britain in 1931, <a href="https://www.nee.google.com">where</a> he worked in business. In December 1938, a friend asked Winton to come to Prague <a href="https://www.nee.google.com">2</a> (aid) people, most of them Jewish, escaping from the Nazis. Seeing people living in terrible conditions and whose lives were <a href="https://www.nee.google.com">3</a> danger, Winton decided to help send children to <a href="https://www.nee.google.com">4</a> (safe) in Britain. He found families for the children and used <a href="https://www.nee.google.com">5</a> (donate) funds and his own money to pay for per child. By August 1939, Winton had saved 669 children.
- For the most part, he did not mention the children he saved, which made his actions soon addresses disappear from people's memories.
