Nicholas Winton, born on 19 May 1909 in London, once worked in banks in Germany and France after school and returned to Britain in 1931, 1 **where** he worked in business. In December 1938, a friend asked Winton to come to Prague 2 **to aid** (aid) people, most of them Jewish, escaping from the Nazis. Seeing people living in terrible conditions and whose lives were 3 **in** danger, Winton decided to help send children to 4 **safety** (safe) in Britain.
