## 考点1 *dare modal verb*. 胆敢，敢于；v. 胆敢，敢于；激将

### 原句再现

But there are still some dishes that Dad **dare** not try even after many years of marriage to my mother.



## 词块积累

< dare to do sth. (这里为实义动词，与其它实义动词用法相同)  
dare sb. to do sth.

dare not do sth. (这里为情态动词) = don't dare (to) do sth. 不敢做某事

I dare say (这里为情态动词) 我敢说；我相信





## 精品例句

1. I'm now up to my ears in debt and **dare** not borrow any more money.

我现在是债台高筑，再也不敢借钱了。

2. We must **dare** to think, speak up and act.

我们必须敢想、敢说、敢做。

3. We dare not play jokes on him in case he becomes angry.

我们不敢对他开玩笑，怕他生气。

a happy marriage 幸福的婚姻

A marry B. A 与B结婚 (注: 不能说 A marry with B)

marry A to B. 把A 嫁给B

be married to sb. (表状态, 可以与一段时间状语连用) 与...结婚

get married to sb. (表动作, 不能与一段时间状语连用) 与...结婚

## 考点4 suffer v. (身体或精神上)受苦；遭受

### 原句再现

We all love roast beef and vegetables, but Mum says we'd better not eat too much roast food as it may make us **suffer** from heat inside our bodies, according to traditional Chinese medicine.



## 词块积累

suffering *n.* 受苦，苦难

sufferer *n.* 受苦者，受难者

suffer a heart attack 心脏病突发

suffer作及物动词时，指遭受一般的痛苦、损害等，其宾语一般是loss, pain, punishment, defeat, hardship, disappointment等。

suffer作不及物动词时，常与from连用。suffer from指遭受战争、自然灾害带来的苦难及患病之苦。



## 精品例句

1. A large quantity of money has been collected to help those **suffering** from the floods.

已经募集了大量的善款来帮助那些遭受洪灾的人们。

2. The graduate **suffered** a defeat in the job interview.

这名毕业生在求职面试时遭遇了失败。

3. Our life is becoming better and better while in some countries there are still some people suffering from hunger.

我们的生活越来越好，但在一些国家有些人仍在挨饿。
