Shane O' Neill writes in *The Washington Post*, "If you're a famous comedian, you may get the frightening 'Tell me a joke!' from a stranger. If you think that's bad, try being a professional whistler." "It happens all the time," said Molly Lewis with a smile. "Sometimes I'll oblige."

Lewis released her album, *On the Lips*, in February, to promote whistling. "People often don't know much about whistle music apart from some pop songs," Lewis said. "But I think it's a beautiful instrument."

People gradually notice whistle music. She whistled a singer's *What Was I Made For?* appeared in the Barbie movie.

Lewis adds depth to whistling, which is usually seen as cheerful or absent-minded. She is inspired by artists like the couple, Marty and Elayne. "They played for 37 years, five nights a week, and it was very special," Lewis said.

## C

Humor has long been recognized for its positive effects, even in the darkest times. Laughter serves as a bridge, helping individuals get through pain. This is shown in Amy Herzog's new play, *Mary Jane*. The play balances humor and heartbreak, providing a fresh idea on the trials of care-giving and the strength of the human spirit.

*Mary Jane* tells the story of a single mother who raises her disabled son, Alex. The play explores friendship, unconditional mother love, and hope and despair. Despite all the challenges she faces, Mary Jane's life is filled with humor, offering the audience brief respites (喘息) from her emotional trouble.

The play focuses on the characters' emotional and psychological experiences rather than the physical presence of Alex who is mostly hidden from the audience. This is achieved by showing the influence of Alex's condition through the eyes of those who care for him. The audience feels the weight of his absence and his various needs, which take up most of Mary Jane's life. Mary Jane tries hard to meet the demands of her job while managing her son's constant medical needs. Her interactions with the supporting characters show the importance of community support and humor that help her fight with her daily struggles. One of the most moving parts of the play is that of Mary Jane's interactions with other mothers of disabled children. They exchange advice, encourage and entertain each other with humor.

Norman Cousins, a professor, recorded his recovery from a severe illness through daily laughter. Cousins discovered that

ten minutes of genuine laughter had an anesthetic (麻醉的) effect and gave him at least two hours of pain-free sleep. His findings show humor's physical and psychological benefits.

Research also supports the importance of laughter and humor, showing that it can reduce stress, improve mood and resilience. Humor positively and directly affects people's health. This indicated that humor could buffer against stress and improve overall mental health.

Screens are replacing paper in almost every area of communication, but is this good for our mental health? Research shows that reading has many mental health benefits, yet most people choose screen time over books for entertainment. Even in schools, digital learning is taking over, making backpacks lighter but challenging students to stay focused.

Reading short posts on social media reduces our attention span, making long books harder to enjoy. This type of reading also uses simple language, offering less exposure to rich vocabulary and ideas. Research indicates that comprehension is six to eight times better with physical books than e-readers. While people may read faster on devices, distractions (使人分心的事物) like social media, ads, and notifications (通知) often prevent them from remembering what they read. Physical books provide a more immersive experience, helping readers understand and remember the content better.

Holding a book, turning its pages, and highlighting favorite parts engage the body. Researchers say turning pages helps create a "mental map", linking what we read to specific pages, which aids memory. The physical actions of reading a book-how you hold it, how your eyes move across the pages-create a unique experience. Unlike e-books, physical books offer a tangible (可感知的) experience, which is important for building strong mental connections.

Physical books also offer a social experience that e-readers do not. Visiting a bookstore, asking a librarian for recommendations, or sharing a book with a friend are enjoyable aspects of reading. These social interactions are missed when downloading e-books.
