Assessment and diagnosis



Collecting patient information

This involves gathering details about the patient's health status, medical history, and current symptoms

Performing physical assessments

Diagnosis health issues

Based on the collected information and physical assessments, nurses identify potential health problems and needs





Plan formulation and implementation



Developing a care plan

Based on the evaluations and feedback, nurses identify areas for improvement and make necessary changes to enhance the quality of care provided







Principles of cross cultural communication



Respect for cultural differences

Recognize and examine the unique cultural backgrounds and beliefs of patients

Patient centered approach

Tailor communication strategies to meet the needs and preferences of individual patients

Use of clear and simple language

Average complex medical jargon and use plain language to facilitate understanding

Cultural sensitivity and awareness

Be aware of cultural differences in communication styles and adapt accordingly





Effective communication skills and methods



Active listening

Give patients the opportunity to express their concerns and listen attentively to their needs



Use of open-ended questions

Encourage patients to share more information by asking open-ended questions



Nonverbal communication

Utilize eye contact, facial expressions, and body language to understand and be understood



Clear and concise instructions

Provide clear, step-by-step instructions to patients in a manner that is easy to understand
