考查形容词。healthy 形容词，健康的；clean 形容词，干净的；quiet 形容词，安静的；warm 形容词，温暖的。keep 动词，保持。根据上一句句意推测可知，在图书馆里应该是要保持安静，quiet 符合题意。故选 C。

2. C

解析：C

**【详解】**

句意：——你愿意和我一起玩《王者荣耀》吗？——哦，不。这是世界上我最不想做的一件事。

本题考查形容词。loud 大声的，large 大的，last 最后的，lost 迷路的，失去的。根据 no 可知，表示不想要去玩《王者荣耀》，the last thing 最不想要的事，故选 C。

### 3. B

解析: B

【详解】

句意: 今晚电视将直播篮球赛。

考查形容词辨析。lively 生机勃勃的, 活跃的; live 活的; 现场直播的; living 活着的; alive 活着, 在世。根据“be covered \_\_\_\_ on TV”可知, 这里是篮球比赛通过电视现场直播的。故选 B。

### 4. D

解析: D

【详解】

句意: 我居住的附近没有机场。最近的一个大约有 90 英里远。

考查形容词辨析。busiest 最忙碌的; farthest 最远的; newest 最新的; nearest 最近的。根据 There isn't an airport near where I live. 可知, 这里表示“最近的机场”, 故选 D。

解析: D

【详解】

句意: 众所周知, 坏心情会影响我们的健康。

考查形容词辨析。unusual 不寻常的; special 特殊的; general 普遍的; common 通常的。根据英语表达习惯, common knowledge 意为“常识”, 符合句意, 故选 D。

### 6. A

解析: A

【详解】

句意: 我的英语老师是一位很有耐心的女士, 她经常反复地纠正我的发音。

考查形容词辨析。patient 耐心的; creative 有创造力的; modest 谦虚的; curious 好奇的。根据 she often corrects my pronunciation again and again, 可知, 她经常反复地纠正我的发音, 说明她很有耐心, 故选 A。

### 7. D

解析: D

【详解】

句意: ——在这么长的寒假期间你开启了什么新技能? ——做饭。它在人们中变得更加受欢迎, 现在我会做美味的菜了。

考查形容词辨析。exciting 令人兴奋的; difficult 困难的; different 不同的; popular 流行的, 受欢迎的。根据语境可知, It 代指的是 Cooking, 做饭变得很受欢迎, 所以说话人学习做饭。故选 D。

### 8. A

解析: A

【详解】

句意：——哇，《寄生虫》赢得了今年的奥斯卡最佳影片奖。——当我听到这个消息的时候，我真的很惊讶，因为这是亚洲电影首次获得该奖项。

考查形容词辨析。surprised 吃惊的，惊讶的；lucky 幸运的；confident 自信的；sure 确信的。根据句中“because it is the first time that an Asian film won the award”可知，这是亚洲电影首次获得该奖项，所以此处使用 surprised，表示“听到这部电影的获奖消息的时候很惊讶”。故选 A。

## 9. C

解析：C

【详解】

句意：我的妹妹很好奇，她总是向我询问各种各样奇怪的问题。

考查形容词辨析。creative 创造性的，有创造力的；wise 明智的；curious 好奇的，求知欲强的；generous 慷慨的。根据句中“she always asks me different kinds of strange questions.”可知她总是问我各种各样奇怪的问题，故可以推测出她是一个好奇的小孩。故选 C。

## 10. B

解析：B

【详解】

句意：——你的收音机怎么了？——出来的声音不清楚。

考查形容词辨析，clean 清洁的，清白的；clear 清晰的，干净的；fresh 新鲜的；well 健康的，明智的。根据提问是问的收音机，那么应该是声音听不清，故选 B。

## 11. B

解析：B

【详解】

句意：——对不起，我不知道彩虹有多少种颜色。——你在开玩笑吗？这只是常识。

考查形容词辨析。natural 自然的；general 普遍的，总的，常规的；proper 正确的，恰当的；ancient 古代的，古老的。general knowledge: 常识。根据常识可知“彩虹有 7 种颜色”，结合上文“我不知道彩虹有多少种颜色”可知此句是“你在开玩笑吗？这只是常识。”故选 B。

## 12. B

解析：B

【详解】

句意：我喜欢收集旧邮票，因为它们很有价值。

考查形容词辨析。simple 简单的；valuable 有价值的；impossible 不可能的；natural 自然的。根据“I like collecting old stamps”可知旧邮票是有价值的，所以喜欢收藏。故选 B。

## 13. A

解析：A

【详解】

句意：青少年感到有点担心和压力是很常见的，因为我们大多数人都有这样的感觉。

考查形容词辨析，common 常见的；strange 不平常的，奇怪的；curious 好奇的；energetic

精力充沛的。根据后半部分“because most of us have such feelings.”那么应该是常见的，故选 A。

#### 14. C

解析：C

【详解】

句意：现代科技能帮助医生在线治疗病人，真是太神奇了！

考查形容词辨析。private 私人的；famous 著名的；amazing 惊人的，神奇的；traditional 传统的。根据“modern technology can help doctors treat patients online”可知，此处感慨科技的神奇，故选 C。

#### 15. B

解析：B

【详解】

句意：——你觉得在武汉的医生怎么样，马林？——他们多么勇敢啊！他们尽了最大努力让病人活下来。

考查形容词辨析。live 活的，主要作定语，修饰动物和植物；alive 活着的，主要用作表语，用于人或物；living 活着的，可用作表语或定语，可用于人或物；lively 活泼的。根据句中“keep patients”可知，此处是“医生很勇敢，他们尽了最大努力让病人活下来”，所以排除 D 项；keep sb.+adj.使某人怎么样，形容词作宾语补足语，living 通常是客观描述某人“尚在人间”或“健在”，而 alive 则主要指生与死的“界限”，所以此处使用 alive，keep sb. alive 让某人活着。故选 B。

#### 16. D

解析：D

【详解】

句意：——我真不敢相信这么有学问的人犯了这么愚蠢的错误。——难道你不知道常识比知识更有价值吗。

考查形容词辨析。general 普遍的；usual 通常的；special 特殊的；common 普通的。固定搭配“常识 common sense”，故选 D。

#### 17. D

解析：D

【详解】

句意：汤姆，别生班长的气。他只是有点严格，但实际上他对我们每个人都很好。

考查形容词。polite 有礼貌的；brave 勇敢的；modest 谦虚的；strict 严格的；根据“but in fact he's kind to us each.”可知实际上他对我们每个人都很好，可推测出此处是“严格”，故选 D。

#### 18. B

解析：B

【分析】

【详解】

句意：——这是一份令人兴奋的报告。你一定要读。——哦，是的。上面说我们学校在篮球决赛中获胜了。

考查形容词。excited 激动的；exciting 令人激动的；bored 无聊的；boring 令人厌烦的；根据句意理解及后句的回答 It says our school won the basketball final.可知，这里指的是“一个激动人心的报告”，而空格在句中修饰的是 report，英语中修饰物要用 ing 形容词，故选 B。

**【点睛】**

英语中分词形容词的用法要牢记。分为-ed 形容词和-ing 形容词，而要用哪个形式，取决于在句中的修饰成分，如果修饰物，就要用-ing 形容词，一般译为“令人……的”；而如果修饰人，就要用-ed 形容词，一般译为“感到……的”，所以做题的时候要分清是修饰人还是物，选择合适的对应形式。本题是修饰 report，是修饰物，所以用-ing 形容词。

**19. B**

解析：B

**【详解】**

句意：海伦正在看一场电视直播的篮球赛，虽然没有在现场，但是仍然可以为他的球队加油。

考查形容词辨析。lively 活泼的，活跃的，充满生气的；live 活着的，实况转播的；living 活着，尚在人间的；alive 活着。根据句意，因为海伦没有在现场，所以只能看电视直播，所以用 live。故选 B。

**20. C**

解析：C

**【详解】**

句意：——很抱歉，我付不起出国的费用。——（那么）去价格更低一点的乡村旅行怎么样？

考查形容词比较级的用法。cheaper 较便宜的，cheap 的比较级形式。higher 较高的，high 的比较级形式。lower 较低的，low 的比较级形式。less 较小的，little 的比较级形式。在英语中，常用 high 和 low 来描述 price 的高低；expensive 和 cheap 不能修饰 price，而是直接放在具体物品前作定语。由上文句意可知，下文句意为“（那么）去价格更低一点的乡村旅行怎么样？”故选 C。

**21. B**

解析：B

**【详解】**

句意：郑先生是如此的慷慨，以至于他捐了 500 万给他家乡的学校。
