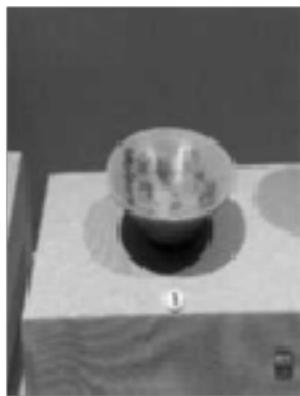

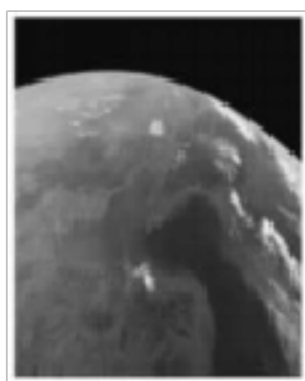


Postal goods for Year of the Rabbit

The Year of the Rabbit will start on Jan 22, the first day of Chinese New Year. Every year an artist is asked to design two zodiac stamps, and the designer for the Year of the Rabbit is Huang Yongyu, age 98, who has been asked to do the job several other times. One stamp shows a blue rabbit holding a pencil and an envelope and text wishing for wisdom(智慧); another stamp shows three rabbits colored white, yellow and light blue running head to toe in a circle with a red background. At the center is the Jade Rabbit, a company of Chang'e, the moon goddess in Chinese traditional story.



A porcelain(瓷) bowl dating back to the Tang Dynasty(唐朝) has been on show for the first time at the Changsha Museum. A poem(诗歌) is found on the bowl. The bowl was discovered at a kiln site in Changsha (长沙窑遗址). A total of 110 poems on other porcelains also have been found at the kiln. The poems recorded what life was like in Changsha in the Tang Dynasty. "Most of them were written by kiln workers and other common people." said Zhang Haijun, a researcher of the museum.



Astronaut Impresses with Language Skills

Zhang Huichun, 65, is a master of making Wuyi Rock Tea. The smell of this tea has never left him in his life.

Since his parents worked in a tea factory in Wuyi Mountain, he loved drinking tea at a young age. After finishing high school, he planted tea plants and picked tea leaves for the factory. In 1980, he learned to make tea and opened his own factory.

To his surprise, the skills of tea making were very complex. After 10 years of learning, he could finally make the tea by himself.

Zhang said there are 13 steps to make it, including drying, shaking, frying and roasting (焙火). The most difficult one for him was shaking. It takes strength and patience (耐) to shake the tea leaves by holding the round bamboo trays. “You have to decide when the best time is to stop according to the color,” Zhang said. Sometimes you stop after shaking several times, while sometimes it can be hundreds of times. Only years of experience can help you make the decision.

The last step —roasting, is also important. It decides the quality. With three stages, it usually takes more than 20 hours! Each stage needs temperatures from 125°C to 155°C. Tea makers have to keep a close eye on the process. “Every 50 minutes, you have to turn over the leaves, or it might burn,” Zhang said.

Although he’s already a master, Zhang said he is still learning. The most fascinating part is that every step is full of changes — different tea plants, weather and temperatures. Every time is an adventure (冒险). ”

In recent years, Zhang has often worked with schools to train tea makers. “It’s my responsibility to pass on the traditional skills.” he said.
