A weekly schedule may not solve all your problems, but it will force you to realize what is happening to your time。

Develop a good attitude about tests

The purpose of a test is to show what you have learned about a subject. They help you remember your new knowledge. The world won't end if you don't pass a test, so don't overly worry.

Study regularly

When you get home from school, go over your notes. Review the important points that your teacher mentioned in class. If you know what the teacher is going to discuss the next day, read that material. This will help you understand the next class. If you do

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these things regularly,

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the material will become more meaningful , and you will remember it longer。

Make good use of your time in class

Take advantage of class time to listen to everything the teacher says。 Really listening in class means less work later. Taking notes will help you remember what the teacher says.

Find a good place to study

Look around the house for a good area。 Keep this space, which may be a desk or simply a corner of your room, free of everything but study materials. No games, radios, or television ! When you sit down to study, concentrate on the subject.

From the earliest times, man has been interested in art。 People have often worked together to collect and save the world's art treasures。

Fine art treasures from many countries are kept in an art museum called the Louvre in Paris, France。 The works of art have been collected by the people of France over many centuries. The Louvre has not always been a museum. The first building was a fort (炮台)。 In 1190, it was the king's castle with high walls and a round tower. It had a moat to prevent his enemies from walking in。

Over the years, the number of buildings around the castle grew。 By 1350, the castle was no longer needed as a fort. The Louvre became a palace home for French kings and queens.

During times of peace, new treasures were brought in。 During days of war, many treasures were stolen, and the buildings were damaged。

When Francis I became king of France in 1515, he brought in artists from many countries。 One of the artists was Leonardo da Vinci from Italy。 Da Vinci's "Mona Lisa" is the best known painting in the museum today。

In 1793, the Louvre became a public museum, just as it is now。 It is a place where art treasures have been saved for everyone to

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enjoy。

No poem should ever be discussed or “analyzed”, until it has been read aloud by someone, teacher or student. Better still, perhaps, is the practice of reading it twice, once at the beginning of the discussion and once at the end, so the sound of the poem is the final thing one hears of it.

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All discussions of poetry are, in fact, preparations for reading
it

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aloud, and the reading of the poem is, finally, the most telling “interpretation” of it, suggesting tone, rhythm, and meaning all at once. Hearing a poet read the work in his or her own voice, on records or on film, is obviously a special reward. But even those aids to teaching can not replace the student and teacher reading it or, best of all, reciting it.

I have come to think, in fact, that time spent reading a poem aloud is much more important than “analyzing” it, if there isn't time for both. I think one of our goals as teachers of English is to have students love poetry. Poetry is “a criticism of life”, and “a heightening (提升) of life”. It is “an approach to the truth of feeling”, and it “can save your life”. It also deserves a place in the teaching of language and literature more central than it presently occupies.

I am not saying that every English teacher must teach poetry. Those who don't like it should not be forced to put that dislike on anyone else. But those who do teach poetry must keep in mind a few things about its essential nature, about its sound as well as its sense, and they must make room in the classroom for hearing poetry as well as thinking about it.

Good health is the most valuable thing a person can have, but one cannot take good health for granted. It is important to remember that the body needs proper care in order to be healthy. There are three things that a person can do to help stay in good shape : eat right food, get enough sleep, and exercise regularly.

Proper nutrition (营养) is important for good health. Your body cannot work well unless it receives the proper kind of "fuel"(燃料). Don't eat too much food with lots of sugar and fat. Eat plenty of

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foods high in protein(蛋白质), like meat, fish, eggs and nuts。 Vegetables and fruits are very important because they provide necessary vitamins (维他命) and minerals。 However, don't over eat。 It is not helpful to be overweight。

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Getting the proper amount of sleep is also important. If you don't get enough sleep, you feel tired and easily get angry。 You have no energy。 Over a long period of time a little a amount of sleep may even result in a change of personality (人的个性)。 Be sure to allow yourself from seven to nine hours of sleep each night. If you do, your body will feel strong and refreshed, and your mind will be sharp.

Finally, get plenty of exercise. Exercise firms the body , strengthens the muscles, and prevents you from gaining weight。 It also improves your heart and lungs 。 If you follow a regular exercise program, you will probably increase your life—span (寿命)。 Any kind of exercise is good。 Most sports are excellent for keeping the body in good shapes : basketball , swimming, bicycling, running and so on are good examples. Sports are not only good for your body, but they are enjoyable and interesting, too.

If everybody were to eat the right foods, get plenty of sleep and exercise regularly , the world would be a happier and healthier place. We would all live to be much older and wiser。
