

Analysis of Trade Competitiveness between China
and Other BRICS Countries
—— Based on CCI and CSI Index

基于 CCI 和 CSI 指数的——中国与其他金砖国家之间的贸易竞争力分析

Abstract

In recent years, most of the GDP growth rates of the BRICS countries have shown a downward trend, and internationally believes that BRICS countries will have more competition, also affect the trade between them. Analyzing the trade import and export issues among BRICS countries can continuously improve the cooperation mechanism among countries, promote the development of trade import and export between China and other BRICS countries, relieve the pressure brought by the China-US trade war and consolidate the cooperation among BRICS countries. This paper choose CSI index (competitive stress index) and CCI index (competitive complementarities index) from (Fan G., Kwan C.H., & Yao Z.Z., 2006) and collect the total trade export volume of BRICS countries from 2000 to 2018, including all kinds of products, and calculate the competitiveness and complementarity between China and other countries, which can provide more comprehensive advice for China's trade with other BRICS countries

Theoretically, this paper can replenish the lack of research on the impact of trade competitiveness on exports about China with other BRICS countries, and has certain significance. From a practical point of view, it provides a basis for China's future export trade to other BRICS countries.

By studying the CSI index and CCI index of BRICS countries, this paper finds that China and other BRICS countries are more complementary to each other and the competition is declining year by year. China's trade competition pressure on other BRICS countries has also decreased in some commodity exports. It not only refuted the relevant arguments, but also indicated that China can has better trade cooperation and economic development space with other BRICS countries.
