第二档(13—16分):紧扣主题,覆盖所有要点;语法结构比较多样, 词汇比较丰富;使用了一定的语句问衔接手段,全文结构比较清晰, 意义比较连贯;有少量语言错误,但基本不影响意思表达。

第三档 (9-12 分): 基本覆盖所有要点, 个别要点表达不清楚或不合理: 基本准确地使用语法结构和词汇: 有语句间衔接手段, 全文结

构相对清晰,意义基本连贯;有些许错误,但基本不影响理解。

第四档(5-8分):遗漏或未清楚表达部分内容要点,或一些内容与写作主题无关;所用词汇有限,语法结构简单,错误较多,影响理解; 几乎未能有效使用语句问衔接手段,全文结构不够清晰,意义不够连贯。

第五档(1-4分): 遗漏或未清楚表达大部分内容要点, 或大部分内容与写作主题不相关;所用词汇非常有限,语法结构简单,错误很多,

严重影响理解;未有效使用语句间衔接手段,全文结构不清晰,意义

不连贯。

第六档 (0 分): 未作答; 所写内容无法看清以致无法评判; 所写内

容与题目要求完全不相关; 抄袭试卷中的其它阅读文本材料。
