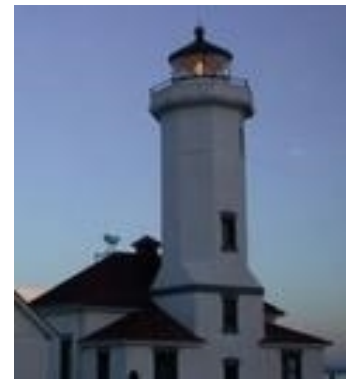

- 疑问式用need+人称+do?
- 否认式用need not (needn't) ， 如：
  - —Need we leave soon?
  - —Yes, you must.
  - —No, you needn't

- =It was not necessary for you to hurry, but you did.
