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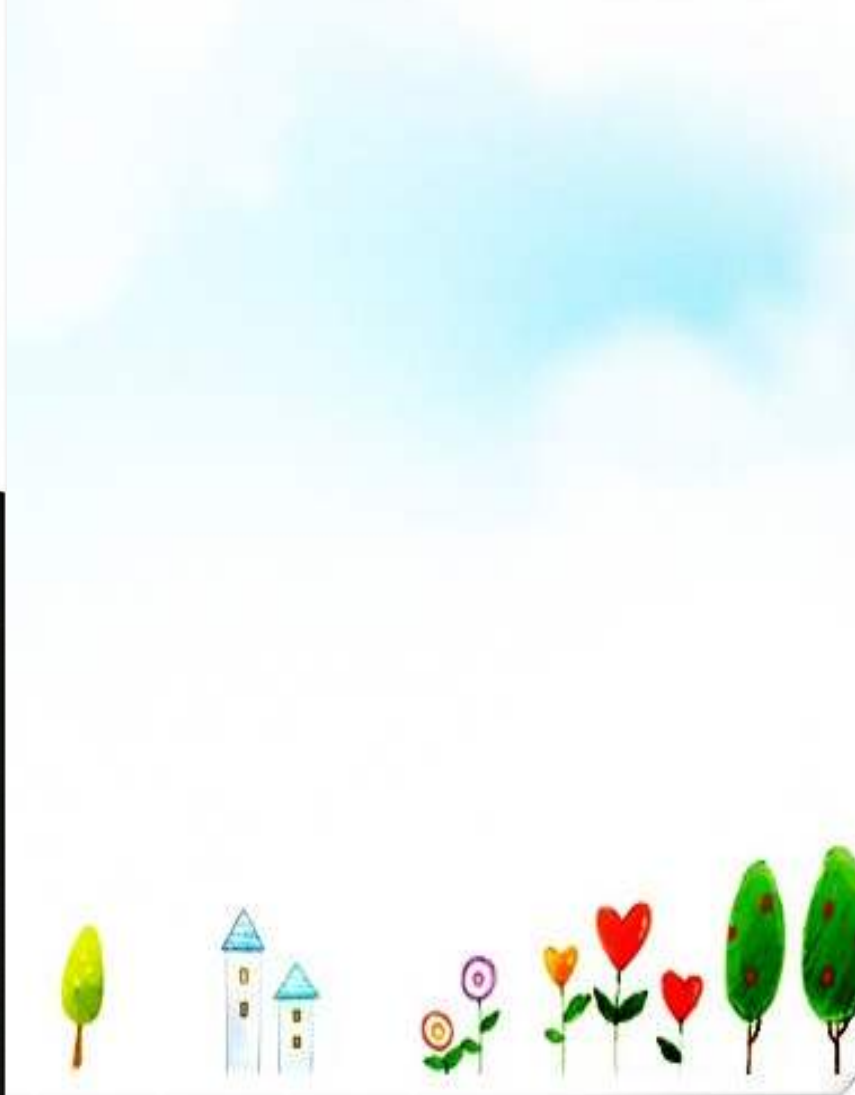
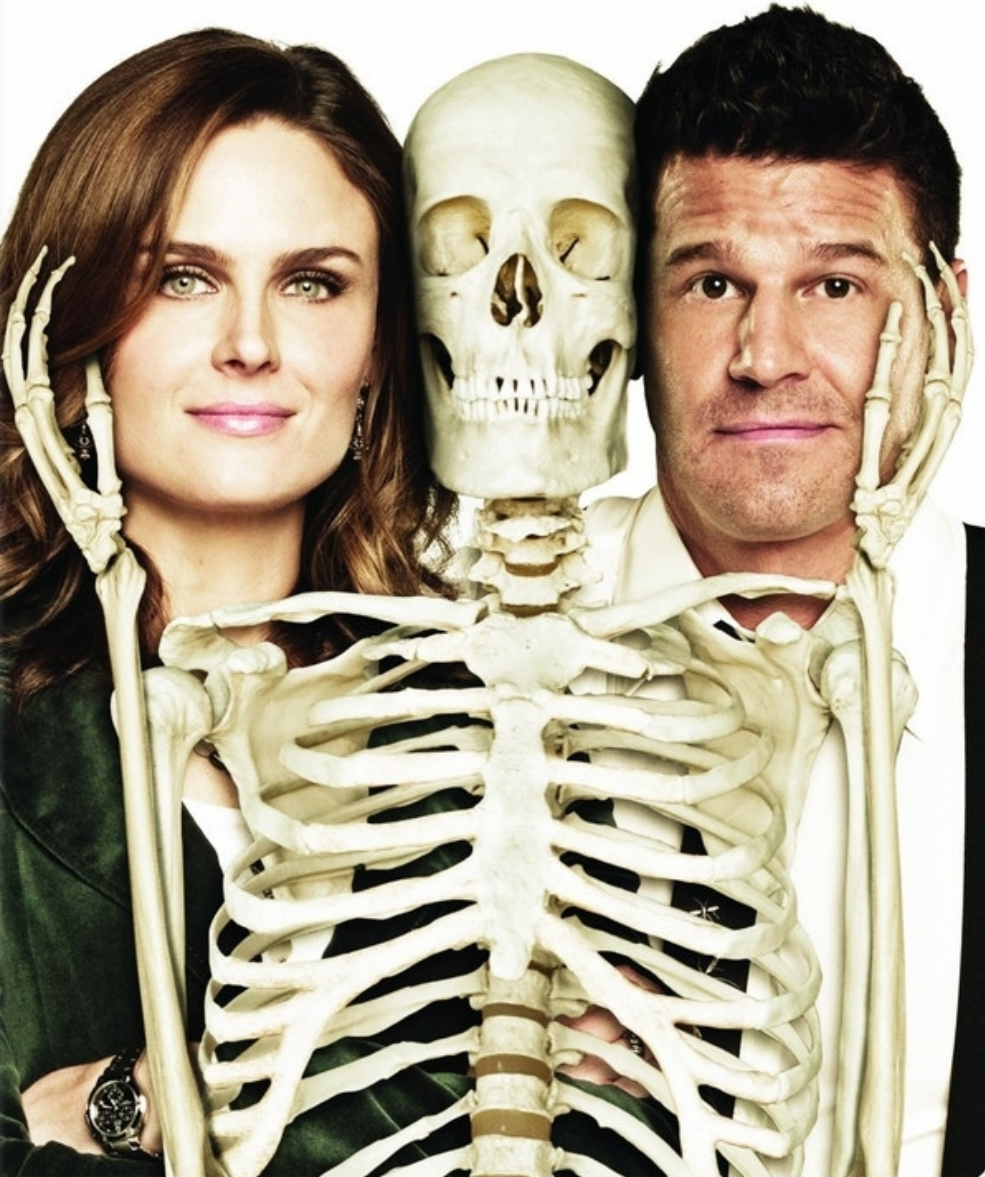

commit v. 犯（罪、错）

① If someone commits a crime or a sin, they do something illegal or bad.

vt. 犯（罪），做（错事、坏事等）

他以前从来没有犯过罪。

He has never committed any crime before.

今天早上8点钟发生了一起凶杀案。

A murder was committed at 8 o'clock this morning.

② ~ sb/oneself (to sth/to doing sth) make it impossible for sb/oneself not to do sth, or to do sth else, esp because of a promise; pledge sb/oneself

使某人[自己]不能不做某事或不做另事（尤指因有承诺）；向某人[自己]保证：（经常与反身代词连用）

在缔结婚姻之前，你们应该更好地相互了解

。

You should know each other better before committing yourselves to marriage.

他使他的朋友答应参加比赛。

He has committed his friend to taking part in the race.

'Do you always catch such an early train?'
