一、选材特点解读

应用文满分作答解题妙招

- 1.体裁上，以广告信息类为主，主要包括启事类应用文、新闻类应用文和识记类应用文。
- 2.题材上，主题围绕“人与自我、人与社会、人与自然”三大主题语境。常见的话题以介绍乘车信息、景点指南、赛事须知、设施功能、社会热点、工作项目、演出介绍等为主，这些材料都与日常生活密切相关。
- 3.选材上，几乎都出自英美报刊及主流网站，内容贴近生活。
- 4.形式上，文章有标题、小标题、粗体、斜体，偶尔也有插图、表格或独立的图片。另外，标题、小标题及重要信息一般会加粗。
- 5.语言上，言简意赅，字数少而信息量大。里面有大量的地道表达，使用很多人名、地名和专有名词，缩写词也比较多。

二、命题特点解读

- 1.命题形式，主要以细节理解题为主。有的可以直接从原文中找到答案，有的是原文的同义替换。考查的都是在真实情境中解决问题的能力。
- 2.命题分布，一般设题数量和片段数量基本相当，考点分布比较均匀。在比较长的段落中有时会设置两个题；考点还可能出现在特殊的地方，如表格中 2020 年全国 I 卷第 23 题；或文章主体段落以外的地方。
- 3.提问形式，题干中多出现 what, which, when, where, who, how long, how much 等疑问词。
- 4.设题特点，段首段尾处常考（2020 新课标卷 21 题、22 题）；表格出现处常考（2023 新课标 I 卷 22 题）；时间数字处常考（2024 新课标 21 题；2023 新课标 22 题；2022 新课标 22 题；2020 新课标 21 题；）。

三、最佳解题步骤

- 1.题目中，确定定位词语。人名、地名、专有名词、时间、数字等容易辨别与扫读出的信息优先划出。独特的名词优先于独特的动词，而独特的动词优先于独特的形容词、副词。一般确定 2-4 个定位词。
- 2.文章中，选定目标句子。根据定位词找回原文，先读当句，再读下句，最后读上句，实在找不到，再到其它地方寻找。
- 3.对比选项中，锁定最佳选项。找出原文重现或与原文同义转换的选项，简称“一一对应”。

四、实用答题妙招

1. 阅读理解应用文细节理解题居多，落实“题文同序”和“同义替换”。
2. 数据计算题注重“原文定位”“细节理解”，弄清来龙去脉再计算。
3. 文章出处题注意利用首尾段相关关键词作答。同时关注选项的差异。
4. 写作意图题要结合试题内容类型，尤其是首尾段做出合理推测判断。
5. 写作对象题需要结合首尾段关键信息，对象可能是家长、游客等等。
6. 满分策略：读题干→找原文→做标记→留痕迹→看选项→扣字眼。

BookLife Prize is an annual writing competition in two Contests (Fiction and Nonfiction) sponsored by BookLife and Publishers Weekly. The prize seeks to assist outstanding independent authors and discover great written works in nine categories across the two sections.

Prizes

Finalists, ones from each respective submission category of both the Fiction and Nonfiction Contests, will receive an introduction from a bestselling author or professional editor serving as a guest judge for the prize, as well as a mention in Publishers Weekly. Each finalist will also receive \$1,000 worth of BookBaby's Facebook and Instagram for Authors service: for each finalist BookBaby will waive (免除) its \$99 setup fee and provide \$250-per-week funds for a four-week campaign. The prize in both the Fiction and Nonfiction Contests is \$5,000 and an author profile in *Publishers Weekly*.

Eligibility (资格) and Submissions

Unpublished or self-published books in the English language are eligible for the BookLife Prize.

Each submission can only be entered into one of the following categories: Romance; Mystery/ Thriller; Science Fiction/ Fantasy/ Horror; General Fiction; Middle-Grade & YA Fiction; Memoir; Self-Help; Inspirational/ Spiritual; and Business/ Personal Finance.

Novels submitted to the Middle Grade & YA Fiction category must contain 30,000 to 100,000 words. All other submissions must contain 40,000 to 100,000 words. Medium-length novel, short fiction, and collections are not eligible for submission. Authors may make multiple submissions.

All submissions must be made before December 1, 2024.

2. 细节理解题。根据 Prizes 部分中“The prize in both the Fiction and Nonfiction Contests is\$5,000(小说类和非小说类竞赛的奖金都是 5000 美元)”可知，获奖者会得到\$5,000 的奖励。故选 D 项。

3. 细节理解题。根据 Eligibility (资格) and Submissions 部分中“Unpublished or self-published books in the English language are eligible for the BookLife Prize.(未出版或自行出版的英文书籍均有资格获得图书奖。)”可知，参赛作品应该用英语写的。故选 B 项。

winter, you can enjoy snowshoeing and skiing, while, during the summer, vacationers can go whitewater rafting on Flathead River and other popular activities. 2. 细节理解题。根据 Festive markets 部分的“Every Tuesday and Saturday, lanes are packed with tents for a festive market where all manner of food, flowers and goods are on offer. Cheese, breads, linen tunics, art, silver, baskets, pottery, hats, handbags and salami are sold, but unlike most markets, there is no bargaining. Genting SkyWorlds Theme Park, Malaysia

Located within Resorts World Genting, about an hour's drive from Malaysia's capital Kuala Lumpur, Genting Sky Worlds Theme Park opened in February 2022. Across the 26-acre park, which cost \$ 800 million and took nearly 10 years to create, visitors will find 26 attractions across nine areas inspired by movies and explorations.

Tickets: \$34 for adults; \$29 for children.

Peppa Pig Theme Park, US

The world's first Peppa Pig Theme Park opened in 2022 in Winter Haven, Florida, and has been delighting children ever since. Dedicated to the classic British animated TV show, where little Peppa has everyday adventures with her friends and family, the 4.5-acre park welcomes pint-sized guests with well-designed, multi-sensory activities across six playscapes.

Tickets: \$34 for adults; \$25 for children.

Ghibli Park, Japan

If you love Hayao Miyazaki's Studio Ghibli animated films, like the Academy Award-winning "Spirited Away" or "My Neighbor Totoro", this new park is for you.

Located outside of Nagoya, Japan, Ghibli Park opened in late 2022. Within the 17.5-acre forested ground of the Expo 2005, guests will find five areas that recreate several animated famous scenes.

Tickets: \$15 for adults; \$7.50 for children.

Katmandu Park, Punta Cana, Dominican Republic

Opened in March 2023 on the east coast of the Dominican Republic, the park is full of mystery. According to legend, explorer Kilgore Goode was on an adventure through Nepal when he came across the "Desirata" jewel, protected by a fierce yeti (雪人). But the discovery turned everything upside down.

【八省期中汇编·阅读·应用文 06】 (24-25 高三上·山西忻州·阶段练习) La Tomatina is a food fight festival held on the last Wednesday of August each year in the town of Bunol close to Valencia in Spain. It is claimed to be the biggest food fight in the world.

What Happens at La Tomatina

At around 11 am, many trucks carry more than one hundred tons of over-ripe tomatoes into the centre of the town, Plaza del Pueblo. Technically the festival does not begin until one brave soul has climbed to the top of a two-story-high wooden pole and reached the ham at the top. In practice this process takes a long time and the festival starts despite no one reaching the prize. The signal for the beginning of the fight is the firing of a water gun. After one hour the fighting ends and the cleaning process begins.

The Rules of La Tomatina

Do not bring bottles or hard objects as they can cause accidents and hurt other participants;

Do not tear other people’s T-shirts;

You must squeeze (捏碎) the tomatoes before throwing them;

As soon as you hear the second shot of the water gun, you must stop throwing tomatoes.

Useful Advice

Wear old shoes and clothes that you do not mind throwing away afterwards. They will most likely end up damaged or incredibly dirty;

Don't wear slippers. You may get hurt, or you could lose them easily during the battle;

If you are not from Bunol, and you want to stay overnight, don't forget to look for and secure accommodation in advance.

Stay safe and enjoy the festivities as much as possible!
