

































(1) 陈述句。

eg:I bought some fruit yesterday.

I didn't buy anything.



















(2) 一般疑问句。

eg:Did you go shopping last Sunday?

Yes, I did./No, I didn't.

(3) 特殊疑问句。

eg:What did you buy?

I bought some apples.

eg:Where did you go last week?
