## (A 部)

1. a (an) [ə, eɪ(ə)n] art.

[英文释义]used before a singular noun that is countable to refer to one person, thing, or object of a particular type.

[例句]I have a book. (我有一本书。)

2. abandon [ə'bændən] v.

[英文释义]to leave someone or something, especially when you should not or when it is difficult to do so; to stop doing something before it is finished.

[例句]He abandoned his wife and children. (他抛弃了他的妻子和孩子。)

3. ability [ə'bɪlɪtɪ] n.

[英文释义]the physical or mental power or skill needed to do something.

[例句]She has the ability to speak three languages. (她有说三种语言的能力。)

4. able [ˈeɪb(ə)l] a.

[英文释义]having the power, skill, means, or opportunity to do something.

[例句]He is able to solve the problem. (他能够解决这个问题。)

5. abnormal [æb'nɔ:m(ə)l] a.

[英文释义]different from what is usual or expected, especially in a way that is not wanted or is worrying.

[例句]His behavior is abnormal. (他的行为很反常。)

6. aboard [ə'bo:d] prep.

[英文释义]on or onto a ship, plane, train, or bus.

[例句]All passengers were soon aboard the plane. (所有乘客很快都登上了飞机。)

7. about [ə'baʊt] ad. & prep.

英文释义 (ad.): approximately; around; in various places.

英文释义 (prep.): concerning; on the subject of; in various places around.

例句 (ad.): It's about five o'clock. (大约五点钟了。)

例句 (prep.): We talked about the plan. (我们谈论了这个计划。)

8. above [ə'baʊv] prep., a., ad.

英文释义 (prep.): higher than something else; over.

英文释义 (a.): located higher up; preceding in a written text.

英文释义 (ad.): in a higher place or position; earlier in a written text.

例句 (prep.): The plane is flying above the clouds. (飞机在云层上方飞行。)

例句 (a.): Please refer to the above example. (请参考上面的例子。)

例句 (ad.): The sky is blue above. (上面的天空是蓝色的。)

9. abroad [ə'brɔ:d] ad.

[英文释义]in or to a foreign country.

[例句]She went abroad for further study. (她出国深造了。)

10. absence [ˈæbsəns] n.

[英文释义]the state of being away from a place or person.

[例句]His absence made us worried. (他的缺席让我们很担心。)

11. absent [ˈæbsənt] a.

[英文释义]not present in a place, at an occasion, or as part of something.

[例句]He was absent from the meeting. (他缺席了会议。)

12. absolutely [ˈæbsəlu:tli] ad.

[英文释义]completely; without any doubt; used to emphasize something.

[例句]It's absolutely true. (这绝对是真的。)

13. absorb [əb'sɔ:b] v.

[英文释义]to take in a liquid, gas, or other substance from the surface or space around; to hold someone's attention completely.

[例句]The sponge absorbs water. (海绵吸水。); He was absorbed in the book. (他全神贯注地读书。)

14. abstract ['æbstrækt] a. & n.

英文释义 (a.): existing in thought or as an idea but not having a physical or concrete existence.

英文释义 (n.): a summary of a written work or speech.

例句 (a.): Beauty is an abstract concept. (美是一个抽象的概念。)

例句 (n.): Please write an abstract of this article. (请写一下这篇文章的摘要。)

15. abuse [ə'bjuz] v.

[英文释义]to use something in a wrong or bad way; to treat someone in a cruel or violent way; to speak to someone in a rude or offensive way.

[例句]He abused his power. (他滥用职权。); She was abused by her husband. (她受到丈夫的虐待。); Don't abuse others. (不要辱骂他人。)

16. academic [ækə'demɪk] a. & n.

英文释义 (a.): related to education, learning, or study, especially at a college or university.

英文释义 (n.): a person who is involved in academic work, especially at a college or university.

例句 (a.): She has an academic background. (她有学术背景。)

例句 (n.): He is a famous academic. (他是一位著名的学者。)

17. accent ['æksənt] n.

[英文释义]a way of pronouncing a language that shows which country, region, or social class a person comes from.

[例句]She has a strong American accent. (她有很重的美国口音。)

18. accept [ək'sept] vt.

[英文释义]to agree to take something that is offered; to believe that something is true or correct; to allow someone to join a group, organization, etc.

[例句]She accepted the gift. (她接受了礼物。); I accept your opinion. (我接受你的意见。); He was accepted into the club. (他被接纳加入了俱乐部。)

19. access ['ækses] n. & v.

英文释义 (n.): a way of entering or reaching a place; the right or opportunity to use something or to see someone.

英文释义 (v.): to obtain or use information stored in a computer.

例句 (n.): The only access to the village is by boat. (到那个村庄的唯一通道是乘船。); Students have access to the library. (学生们可以使用图书馆。)

例句 (v.): He accessed the files on the computer. (他访问了计算机上的文件。)

20. accident ['æksɪdɪnt] n.

[英文释义]an unexpected and often unpleasant event that happens by chance and causes damage, injury, or death.

[例句]There was a car accident on the road. (路上发生了一起车祸。)

21. accommodation [əkəmə'deɪʃ(ə)n] n.

[英文释义]a place to live, work, or stay in; a room or rooms where people can live or stay.

[例句]We need to find accommodation for the night. (我们需要找个地方过夜。)

22. accompany [ə'kʌmpəni] v.

[英文释义]to go somewhere with someone; to be present or happen at the same time as something else.

[例句]He accompanied his mother to the hospital. (他陪他母亲去了医院。); Lightning usually accompanies thunder. (闪电通常伴随着雷声。)

23. according to [ə'kɔ:diŋ tʊ] ad.

[英文释义]as stated by someone or something; in a way that is consistent with something.

[例句]According to the report, the economy is improving. (根据报告, 经济正在好转。)

24. account [ə'kaʊnt] n.

[英文释义]a written or spoken description of something that has happened; a record of money paid or received in a bank, company, etc.

[例句]He gave a detailed account of the accident. (他对事故作了详细的描述。); I have an account with this bank. (我在这家银行有一个账户。)

25. accurate [ˈækjərət] a.

[英文释义]correct in every detail; exact and precise.

[例句]The information is accurate. (这条信息是准确的。)

26. accuse [ə'kju:z] v.

[英文释义]to say that someone has done something wrong or is guilty of something.

[例句]He was accused of stealing. (他被指控偷窃。)

27. ache [eɪk] vi. & n.

英文释义 (vi.): to have a continuous dull pain.

英文释义 (n.): a continuous dull pain.

例句 (vi.): My head aches. (我头疼。)

例句 (n.): I have a toothache. (我牙疼。)

28. achieve [ə'tʃi:v] vt.

[英文释义]to succeed in doing something, especially after trying very hard; to reach a particular goal or standard.

[例句]He achieved his dream of becoming a doctor. (他实现了成为一名医生的梦想。)

29. achievement [ə'tʃi:vmənt] n.

[英文释义]something that someone has succeeded in doing, especially after a lot of effort; the act of achieving something.

[例句]His greatest achievement was winning the championship. (他最大的成就就是赢得了冠军。)

30. acid [ˈæsɪd] a.

[英文释义]having a sour or sharp taste; containing acid.

[例句]Lemons have an acid taste. (柠檬有酸味。)

31. acknowledge [ək'nɒlɪdʒ] v.

[英文释义]to accept or admit that something is true or that someone or something exists; to recognize the importance or quality of someone or something.

[例句]He acknowledged his mistake. (他承认了自己的错误。); She is widely acknowledged as an excellent actress. (她被广泛认为是一位优秀的女演员。)

32. acquire [ə'kwɑɪə(r)] v.

[英文释义]to get something by buying, borrowing, being given it, or obtaining it from a particular source; to gain a skill, quality, or habit.

[例句]He acquired a lot of knowledge from reading. (他通过阅读获得了很多知识。); She acquired a new skill. (她学会了一项新技能。)

33. across [ə'krɒs] prep.

[英文释义]from one side to the other side of something; on the other side of something.

[例句]She walked across the street. (她穿过了街道。)

34. act [ækt] n. & v.

英文释义 (n.): a law or official decision; a part of a play.

英文释义 (v.): to perform in a play, film, etc.; to do something; to behave in a particular way.

例句 (n.): There is an act against smoking in public places. (有一项禁止在公共场所吸烟的法令。); The first act of the play is very interesting. (这出戏的第一幕非常有趣。)

例句 (v.): He acts in a movie. (他在一部电影中表演。); Act quickly, or we'll miss the train. (快点行动, 否则我们会错过火车的。)

35. action [ˈækj(ə)n] n.

[英文释义]the process of doing something; something that is done.

[例句]We need to take action to solve the problem. (我们需要采取行动来解决这个问题。)

36. active [ˈæktɪv] a.

[英文释义]doing things; involved in activity; lively and energetic.

[例句]She is an active member of the club. (她是俱乐部的一名活跃成员。)

37. activity [ækˈtɪvɪtɪ] n.

[英文释义]a thing that people do for pleasure or to achieve a particular aim.

[例句]We have many activities after school. (我们放学后有很多活动。)

38. actor [ˈæktə(r)] n.

[英文释义]a man who performs in a play, film, etc.

[例句]He is a famous actor. (他是一位著名的演员。)

39. actress [ˈæktɪs] n.

[英文释义]a woman who performs in a play, film, etc.

[例句]She is a talented actress. (她是一位有才华的女演员。)

40. actually [ˈæktʃuəli] ad.

[英文释义]in fact; really; used to emphasize the truth of a statement.

[例句]He looks young, but actually he is over 40. (他看起来很年轻, 但实际上他已经40多岁了。)

41. AD n.

[英文释义]in the Christian calendar, used before a date to show that the date comes after the year when Jesus Christ is thought to have been born (Anno Domini).

[例句]The building was built in 200 AD. (这座建筑建于公元200年。)

42. adapt [əˈdæpt] v.

[英文释义]to change something to make it suitable for a new use or situation; to get used to a new situation.

[例句]We need to adapt the plan to the new situation. (我们需要使计划适应新的情况。); He adapted quickly to the new environment. (他很快适应了新环境。)

43. adaptation [ədæpˈteɪʃ(ə)n] n.

[英文释义]the process of adapting to a new situation; a film, play, etc. that has been changed so that it can be performed in a different form.

[例句]The adaptation of the novel into a movie was very successful. (这部小说改编成电影非常成功。)

44. add [æd] vt.

[英文释义]to put something with something else to increase the number, amount, size, etc.; to say something more.

[例句]Add some sugar to the coffee. (在咖啡里加些糖。); He added that he would come

back soon. (他补充说他很快就会回来。)

45. addict [ˈædɪkt] n.

[英文释义] a person who is unable to stop taking harmful drugs; a person who is very interested in something and spends a lot of time doing it.

[例句] He is a drug addict. (他是个吸毒成瘾者。); She is a work addict. (她是个工作狂。)

46. addition [əˈdɪʃ(ə)n] n.

[英文释义] the process of adding something to something else; something that is added.

[例句] The addition of new members made the team stronger. (新成员的加入使团队更强大了。)

47. address [əˈdres] n.

[英文释义] the number of the house, name of the street, and name of the town or city where someone lives or works; a formal speech.

[例句] Please tell me your address. (请告诉我你的地址。); He gave an address at the meeting. (他在会议上发表了讲话。)

48. adjust [əˈdʒʌst] v.

[英文释义] to change something slightly to make it more suitable for a particular purpose; to get used to a new situation.

[例句] You need to adjust the seat to a comfortable position. (你需要把座位调整到舒适的位置。); She adjusted quickly to the new job. (她很快适应了新工作。)

49. administration [ədˈmɪnɪˈstreɪʃ(ə)n] n.

[英文释义] the activities involved in running a business, organization, or government; the people who are in charge of running a business, organization, or government.

[例句] The administration of the company is very efficient. (这家公司的管理非常高效。)

50. admire [ədˈmaɪə(r)] v.

[英文释义] to respect and like someone or something very much; to look at someone or something with pleasure.

[例句] I admire her for her courage. (我因她的勇气而钦佩她。); We all admire the beautiful scenery. (我们都欣赏这美丽的景色。)

51. admit

[英文释义] to agree unwillingly that something is true or that you have done something wrong; to allow someone to enter a place; to accept someone as a member of a school, college, etc.

[例句] He admitted that he had made a mistake. (他承认自己犯了一个错误。)

This ticket admits one person. (这张票允许一人入场。)

She was admitted to the university. (她被这所大学录取了。)

52. adopt

[英文释义] to take someone else's child into your family and legally become its parent; to start to use a particular method, plan, or idea.

[例句] They decided to adopt an orphan. (他们决定收养一个孤儿。)

Our company has adopted a new marketing strategy. (我们公司采用了一种新的营销策略。)

53. adorable

[英文释义] extremely cute and attractive.

[例句] What an adorable little puppy! (多么可爱的一只小狗啊!)

The baby has an adorable smile. (这个婴儿有一个可爱的笑容。)

54. adult

[英文释义] a fully grown person or animal.

[例句] Adults should set a good example for children. (成年人应该为孩子们树立好榜样。)

The adult elephant is much larger than the baby one. (成年大象比小象大得多。)

55. advance

[英文释义] to move forward; to develop or make progress; to move something forward or to a later point in time.

[例句] The soldiers advanced towards the enemy. (士兵们向敌人前进。)

Science has advanced greatly in recent years. (近年来科学有了很大的发展。)

They advanced the date of the meeting. (他们把会议日期提前了。)

56. advantage

[英文释义] a condition or situation that puts you in a better position than other people.

[例句] His fluency in English gives him an advantage over other candidates. (他流利的英语使他比其他候选人更有优势。)

We should take advantage of this opportunity. (我们应该利用这个机会。)

57. adventure

[英文释义] an unusual, exciting, and possibly dangerous experience.

[例句] They had an exciting adventure in the jungle. (他们在丛林里有一次激动人心的冒险经历。)

The boy dreams of having many adventures. (这个男孩梦想着有很多冒险经历。)

58. advertise

[英文释义] to tell people about a product, service, job, etc. in a newspaper, on the Internet, on television, etc.

[例句] They advertised their new product on TV. (他们在电视上为他们的新产品做广告。)

The company is advertising for a new manager. (这家公司正在登广告招聘一名新经理。)

59. advertisement (ad)

[英文释义] a notice, picture, or film telling people about a product, service, job, etc.

[例句] I saw an advertisement for a new car in the newspaper. (我在报纸上看到了一则新车的广告。)

There are many advertisements on the Internet. (互联网上有很多广告。)

60. advice

[英文释义] an opinion that someone gives you about what you should do in a particular situation.

[例句] Can you give me some advice on how to learn English well? (你能给我一些关于如何学好英语的建议吗?)

I followed his advice and it worked. (我听从了他的建议, 而且很有效。)

61. advise

[英文释义] to tell someone what you think they should do in a particular situation.

[例句] I advise you to study harder. (我建议你更努力地学习。)

The doctor advised him to give up smoking. (医生建议他戒烟。)

62. advocate

[英文释义] to speak publicly in support of a particular way of doing something.

[例句] She advocates for environmental protection. (她倡导环境保护。)

Many people advocate free trade. (许多人主张自由贸易。)

63. affair

[英文释义] an event or a series of related events; a matter or situation that you have to deal with.

[例句]The party was a great affair. (那次聚会是一次很棒的活动。)

It's a private affair. (这是一件私人的事情。)

64. affect

[英文释义]to produce a change in someone or something.

[例句]The bad weather affected our plans. (恶劣的天气影响了我们的计划。)

His words affected her deeply. (他的话深深地影响了她。)

65. afford

[英文释义]to have enough money to buy or pay for something; to be able to do something without causing financial problems.

[例句]I can't afford a new car. (我买不起一辆新车。)

We can't afford to waste time. (我们浪费不起时间。)

66. afraid

[英文释义]feeling fear or anxiety; worried or frightened about something.

[例句]She is afraid of dogs. (她害怕狗。)

I'm afraid I can't come to the party. (恐怕我不能来参加聚会了。)

67. Africa

[英文释义]the second largest continent, south of Europe and bordered by the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea, the Indian Ocean, and the Atlantic Ocean.

[例句]He has traveled to many countries in Africa. (他去过非洲的许多国家。)

68. African

[英文释义]a person from Africa; relating to Africa or its people, languages, or cultures.

[例句]African music is very unique. (非洲音乐非常独特。)

Many Africans work hard to improve their lives. (许多非洲人努力改善他们的生活。)

69. after

[英文释义]following in time or order; later than; behind in position.

[例句]After dinner, we went for a walk. (晚饭后,我们去散步了。)

He came after me. (他在我后面来的。)

The cat is after the mouse. (猫在追老鼠。)

70. afternoon

[英文释义]the part of the day between 12 o'clock and the time when it starts to get dark.

[例句]We often play basketball in the afternoon. (我们经常在下打篮球。)

She had a meeting in the afternoon. (她下午有一个会议。)

71. afterward

[英文释义]after a particular event or time; later.

[例句]He had a cup of coffee afterward. (之后他喝了一杯咖啡。)

We went shopping and had lunch afterward. (我们去购物了,然后吃了午饭。)

72. again

[英文释义]another time; once more; in addition.

[例句]Please say that again. (请再说一遍。)

He made the same mistake again. (他又犯了同样的错误。)

We should try again. (我们应该再试一次。)

73. against

[英文释义]in opposition to; touching or leaning on something; used to show a competition or fight.

[例句]He is against the plan. (他反对这个计划。)

The ladder is against the wall. (梯子靠在墙上。)

Our team is playing against their team. (我们队正在和他们队比赛。)

74. age

[英文释义]the number of years that someone has lived or that something has existed; a particular period of history.

[例句]What's your age? (你多大年纪了?)

We are living in the information age. (我们生活在信息时代。)

75. agency

[英文释义]a business or an organization that provides a particular service.

[例句]She works for an advertising agency. (她在一家广告公司工作。)

The travel agency offers many travel packages. (这家旅行社提供很多旅游套餐。)

76. agenda

[英文释义]a list of the things that need to be discussed at a meeting; a plan of things that you want to do.

[例句]The agenda for the meeting includes several important topics. (会议议程包括几个重要议题。)

He has his own agenda. (他有自己的计划。)

77. ago

[英文释义]in the past; before the present time.

[例句]He left here two hours ago. (他两小时前离开了这里。)

The story happened many years ago. (这个故事发生在很多年前。)

78. agree

[英文释义]to have the same opinion as someone else; to say that you will do something.

[例句]I agree with you. (我同意你的看法。)

He agreed to help me. (他同意帮助我。)

79. agreement

[英文释义]a situation in which people have the same opinion; a formal arrangement or promise between two or more people or groups.

[例句]There is an agreement between us. (我们之间达成了一致意见。)

They signed an agreement. (他们签署了一份协议。)

80. agriculture

[英文释义]the science or business of farming.

[例句]Agriculture is the foundation of the national economy. (农业是国民经济的基础。)

Modern agriculture has made great progress. (现代农业取得了很大的进步。)

81. ahead

[英文释义]in front; further forward in space or time; in a leading position.

[例句]He ran ahead of the others. (他跑在其他人前面。)

The future looks bright ahead. (未来前景光明。)

She is ahead of her classmates in English. (她在英语方面领先于她的同学。)

82. aid

[英文释义]help or support; something that helps you to do something.

[例句]They provided aid to the earthquake victims. (他们向地震灾民提供援助。)

A dictionary is a useful aid for learning a language. (字典是学习语言的有用工具。)

83. aim

[英文释义]to point or direct something at a particular person or thing; to have a particular goal or purpose.

[例句]He aimed the gun at the target. (他把枪瞄准目标。)

My aim is to pass the exam. (我的目标是通过考试。)

84. air

[英文释义]the mixture of gases that surrounds the earth and that we breathe; the sky or the space above the ground.

[例句]We need fresh air to breathe. (我们需要新鲜空气来呼吸。)

The plane is flying in the air. (飞机在空中飞行。)

85. airline

[英文释义]a company that provides regular services for carrying passengers and goods by air.

[例句]I booked a ticket on this airline. (我订了这家航空公司的机票。)

Many airlines offer discounts during off-peak seasons. (许多航空公司在淡季提供折扣。)

86. airport

[英文释义]a place where aircraft take off and land and that has buildings for passengers to wait in.

[例句]We will meet at the airport. (我们将在机场见面。)

The new airport is very modern. (新机场非常现代化。)

87. alarm

[英文释义]a device that makes a loud noise to warn people of danger; a feeling of fear or worry.

[例句]The fire alarm went off. (火警警报响了。)

There is no need to alarm. (没有必要惊慌。)

88. alcohol

[英文释义]a liquid that is found in drinks such as beer, wine, and spirits, and that can make you drunk; drinks that contain this liquid.

[例句]He doesn't drink alcohol. (他不喝酒。)

Alcohol can be harmful to your health. (酒精可能对你的健康有害。)

89. alive

[英文释义]living; not dead; full of energy and enthusiasm.

[例句]The fish is still alive. (这条鱼还活着。)

He is always alive and active. (他总是充满活力和积极向上。)

90. all

[英文释义]the whole of something; everyone or everything.

[例句]All of us like music. (我们所有人都喜欢音乐。)

He ate all the food. (他把所有的食物都吃光了。)

91. allow

[英文释义]to let someone do something; to give someone permission to do something.

[例句]My parents allow me to go out at night. (我的父母允许我晚上出去。)

The teacher allowed us to use the dictionary. (老师允许我们使用字典。)

92. almost

[英文释义]nearly; very nearly; not quite.

[例句]It's almost time for class. (快到上课时间了。)

He almost won the race. (他几乎赢得了比赛。)

93. alone

[英文释义]without other people; only; by yourself.

[例句]She lives alone. (她一个人住。)

He is alone in the room. (他一个人在房间里。)

You are not alone in this. (在这件事上你不是一个人。)

94. along

[英文释义]in a line next to something long; from one end to the other of something long; moving in a particular direction.

[例句]There are trees along the road. (沿路有一些树。)

We walked along the river. (我们沿着河边走。)

She drove along the street. (她沿着街道开车。)

95. alongside

[英文释义]next to something or someone; together with something or someone.

[例句]The boat was moored alongside the dock. (船停泊在码头旁边。)

He worked alongside his colleagues. (他和他的同事一起工作。)

96. aloud

[英文释义]using your voice, not silently; so that people can hear you.

[例句]Read the text aloud. (大声朗读这篇课文。)

She laughed aloud. (她大声笑了起来。)

97. already

[英文释义]before the present time or the time you are talking about; earlier than expected.

[例句]I have already finished my homework. (我已经完成了我的家庭作业。)

It's already late. (已经很晚了。)

98. also

[英文释义]in addition; too; as well.

[例句]He can speak English, and he can also speak French. (他会说英语,而且他也会说法语。)

She likes music, and also art. (她喜欢音乐,也喜欢艺术。)

99. alternative

[英文释义]an option or choice that you can make; different from the usual or traditional way of doing something.

[例句]We have no alternative but to wait. (我们除了等待别无选择。)

They are looking for alternative energy sources. (他们正在寻找替代能源。)

100. although

[英文释义]in spite of the fact that; even though.

[例句]Although it was raining, he still went to work. (尽管在下雨,他仍然去上班了。)

She is very happy although she is poor. (尽管她很穷,但她很快乐。)

101. altogether

[英文释义]completely; including everything; in total.

[例句]The experience was altogether positive. (这次经历完全是积极向上的。)

Altogether, we raised a large amount of money for the charity. (总之,我们为慈善机构筹集到了一大笔善款。)

102. always

[英文释义]at all times; on every occasion.

[例句]She always looks on the bright side of life. (她总是看到生活中光明的一面。)

We should always strive to be better than yesterday. (我们应该一直努力比昨天做得更好。)

103. a. m.

[英文释义]in the morning; before midday (ante meridiem).

[例句]We start our morning exercise at 7 a. m. every day to keep fit. (我们每天早上7点开始晨练以保持健康。)

The meeting is scheduled for 10 a. m., and it will surely bring some good

ideas. (会议安排在上午10点, 肯定会产生一些好的想法。)

104. amateur

[英文释义] a person who does a particular activity for pleasure, not as a job; not professional.

[例句] He is an amateur photographer, and his works always capture the beauty of life. (他是一名业余摄影师, 他的作品总是能捕捉到生活的美好。)

The amateur volunteers made great contributions to the community event. (这些业余志愿者为社区活动做出了巨大贡献。)

105. amazing

[英文释义] extremely surprising, impressive, or good.

[例句] It's amazing how much he has achieved in such a short time. (他在这么短的时间内取得了这么大的成就, 真是令人惊叹。)

The view from the top of the mountain is amazing, making all the efforts worthwhile. (山顶的景色令人惊叹, 让所有的努力都值得了。)

106. ambition

[英文释义] a strong desire to achieve something; a goal or aim that you work towards.

111. among

[英文释义]surrounded by; in the middle of; being part of a group of people or things.

112. amount

[英文释义]a quantity or number of something; the total of something.

113. amuse

[英文释义]to make someone laugh or smile; to keep someone interested and entertained.

[例句]His funny stories always amuse us and make our day. (他有趣的故事总是能逗我们开心, 让我们的一天充满欢乐。)

The children's show is designed to amuse and educate young viewers. (这个儿童节目旨在娱乐并教育小观众。)

114. analyse (analyze)

[英文释义]to examine something carefully in order to understand it, explain it, or find out more about it.

[例句]By analyzing the data, we can find the best solution to the problem. (通过分析数据, 我们能够找到解决问题的最佳方案。)

We should analyze our own strengths and weaknesses to improve ourselves. (我们应该分析自己的优缺点来提升自我。)

115. ancestor

[英文释义]a person in your family who lived a long time ago; an early form of an animal or plant from which others have developed.

[例句]Our ancestors left us a rich cultural heritage that we should cherish. (我们的祖先给我们留下了丰富的文化遗产, 我们应该珍惜。)

Learning about our ancestors' wisdom can inspire us to create a better future. (了解我们祖先的智慧可以激励我们创造更美好的未来。)

116. ancient

[英文释义]belonging to a time long ago; very old.

[例句]Ancient civilizations have made great contributions to human progress. (古代文明为人类的进步做出了巨大贡献。)

117. and

[英文释义]used to connect words, phrases, or clauses that are similar or related; also; in addition.

[例句]We should study hard and be kind to others. (我们应该努力学习并且善待他人。)

He is talented and hardworking, which makes him successful. (他有才华又勤奋, 这使他获得了成功。)

118. anger

[英文释义]a strong feeling of being annoyed, irritated, or resentful.
