· ④ He poured some milk and honey into the cup and **mixed** them together.

**popular**      **adj.大众喜爱的；广受欢迎的**



· *例句: This is one of our most **popular** designs.*

这是我们最受欢迎的设计之一。

· 拓展: be popular with受……欢迎

popularity n.受欢迎；普及；流行

• popularly adv. 普遍地；广泛地

• (反)unpopular adj. 不受欢迎的

- ③Exercises of this kind are very **popular**.



## across prep. 在…… 对面



▪ 举例：There's a bank right **across** the street.

• 街对面就有一家银行。

▪ 辨析 across, cross, through 与 pass

across	介词，意为“在…… 对面”。可与go, walk等动词连用，表示“穿过，横穿”，此时与cross可以相互转换，表示从物体表面经过。 如：A dog swam across the river. 狗游过了河。
cross	动词，意为“横穿”，指在物体表面穿过，如马路、桥、河流等。 如：He <b>crossed</b> the road. 他横穿了那条马路。
through	介词，意为“穿过”，指从物体的内部穿过，如森林、隧道等。 如：I walked rapidly <b>through</b> the back door. 我快速地穿过后门。
pass	动词，意为“经过；路过”，指从旁边经过。 如：I <b>passed</b> the back door. 我从后门经过。

· 运用：根据句意，用across, cross, through 或pass 填空。

· ①The sunlight comes through the glass.

· ②Go across the road, and you will find the post office on your left.

· ③Cross the bridge, and you will see a big building.

· ④She passes/me in the street without even saying hello.

senior n. 老年人；长者



· 拓展：senior adj. 级别/地位高的，资深的；（比赛）成人的，高水平的

junior adj. 职位较低的；青少年的

· 例句：The meeting should be chaired by the most **senior** person present.

· 会议应由在座的职位最高的人主持。

## customer n.顾客



- 例句: They know me-I'm a regular **customer**.

我是老主顾，他们都认识我。

- 拓展: custom n.风俗; 个人习惯; 惠顾

## design n.设计



- 例句：The magazine will appear in a new **design** from next month.  
从下个月起这本杂志将以新的设计问世。
- 拓展：design v.设计；制图；构思  
designer n.设计者；构思者
