

The contents of these "pay-for-knowledge" products are from language learning to gardening or baby-caring. Everything you think of can be found online at this moment. "Pay-for-knowledge" is on the rise.

buying online courses may be the kind of people who need them least. In other words, with or without these courses, they can make it anyway because they are those who have the ability to learn by themselves.

In general, the best is the one that suits you most. "Pay-for-knowledge" may be used as a good start for self-growth. Be careful! Otherwise, your dream of success may not come true.

The COVID-19 epidemic (疫情) wave in China has ended. The virus did not rebound (反弹) significantly during the Spring Festival holiday and no new virus mutations (突变) were found, the Chinese Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) said in a report on Jan 25. The overall pandemic is at a low level.

China stopped mass testing (大规模检测) on December 8, 2022, and downgraded (降级) its management of the disease from Class A to Class B on January 8. According to the CDC report, the epidemic wave reached its

highest point in late December and then fell. The number of serious cases and deaths at hospitals has continued to drop off. By late January, the epidemic had waned (减弱).
