



The English Proficiency Test Band 4 is a standardized test used to assess the English proficiency of non native speakers



02

It is designed to evaluate candidates' ability to use English in a range of contexts, including academic, professional, and every day settings

The test assessments candidates' listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills, as well as their grammar and vocabulary knowledge





The Importance of Grammar in English









Grammar is the system of rules that govern the structure and organization of senses in a language

Property grammar usage is essential for effective communication in English, as it ensures clarity, precision, and coherence in written and spooked texts

A good command of grammar enablements English learners to express ideas accurately, develop complex senses, and understand different types of texts






Requirements for the English Proficiency Test Band


4 Grammar Test

Candidates must demonstrate a high level of expertise in English grammar, including knowledge of presence structure, tense usage, and graphical functions

They should be able to analyze complex senses, identify graphical errors, and use appropriate graphical structures in their own writing

Successful candidates must also demonstrate a good understanding of the rules of English punctation and capitalization







The usage of nouns and articles





Nouns

The ability to use nouns correctly, including their regular and singular forms, passive and define articles

Articles

Understanding the difference between define and define articles, and their appropriate usage in context





The Sense and Voice of Verbs



Tense

Prop use of present, past, future, and other compound tensions to discover the correct time context of events

Voice

Understanding and using the active and passive voice correctly in different contexts





The use of non fine verbs



Infinities

Understanding the function of to definitions, bare infinities and their particles in senses

Gerund

Proper use of gerund (verbs used as nouns) in senses





The usage of objectives and advertisements




Adjectives

The ability to choose appropriate objections to describe nouns or modify clauses



Advantageous

Propose use of advertisements to modify verbs, objections or other advertisements, and their placement in appearances

Understanding the different means of common positions and their correct usage in context

Connections

Propose use of coordinating, coordinating, and correlated connections to connect words, phrases, or clauses effectively
