The Importance of Grammar in English



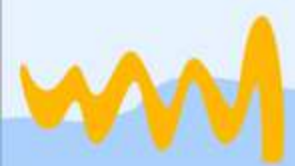
Grammar is the system of rules that govern the structure and organization of senses in a language



Proper grammar usage is essential for effective communication in English, as it ensures clarity, precision, and coherence in written and spoken texts



A good command of grammar enables English learners to express ideas accurately, develop complex sentences, and understand different types of texts





Requirements for the English Proficiency Test Band

4 Grammar Test

Candidates must demonstrate a high level of expertise in English grammar, including knowledge of presence structure, tense usage, and graphical functions

They should be able to analyze complex senses, identify graphical errors, and use appropriate graphical structures in their own writing

Successful candidates must also demonstrate a good understanding of the rules of English punctuation and capitalization

The usage of nouns and articles

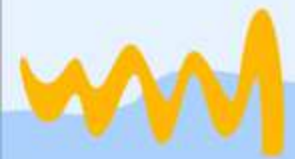


Nouns

The usage of objectives and advertisements



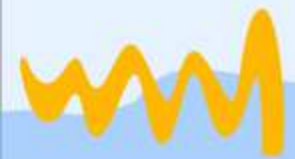
Adjectives

Propose use of advertisements to modify verbs, objections or other advertisements, and their placement in appearances



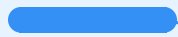

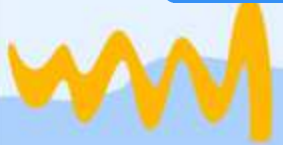
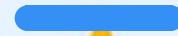
Positions
