在广东省春季高考的完形填空考查中,学生的必备知识和能力:

必备知识

- **丰富的词汇储备**:要掌握《普通高中英语课程标准》要求的词汇量,并且不仅仅是记住单词的拼写和基本释义,还要深入了解词汇的多种含义、用法以及常见的搭配。可以通过阅读英语文章、背诵词汇例句、使用词汇学习工具等方式来加深对词汇的理解和记忆。
- **良好的阅读能力**:具备一定的阅读速度和理解能力是关键。能够快速浏览文章,抓住关键信息,理解文章的主旨大意和细节内容。平时可以通过多读英语原著、报纸杂志、英语短文等材料来提高阅读能力,同时要注意培养阅读技巧,如略读、扫读、精读等,根据不同的阅读目的选择合适的阅读方法。
- 对固定搭配和习惯用法的熟悉: 熟悉常见的固定搭配、短语和习惯用法,这对于在完形填空中准确选择答案至关重要。可以专门整理和背诵一些常见的固定搭配,同时在阅读和练习中不断积累和巩固。
- **一定的文化背景知识**: 了解英语国家的文化背景、风俗习惯、社会生活等方面的知识,有助于更好地理解文章内容,特别是在一些涉及文化背景的语境中,能够更准确地推断出合适的词汇或表达。可以通过观看英语电影、电视剧、阅读文化类书籍等方式来拓宽文化视野。
