A big mirror is built into the wall of its west corridor. The whole garden will be s_88_ in the mirror wherever the visitors are. A pool or a lake in a garden a_89_ serves this purpose. A pool runs from south to north through the garden of Pian Shi Shan Fang. East of the rockery, a man-made moon is reflected (倒映) in the p_90_.

Whatever methods used, every effort is made to achieve the purpose of giving visitors a sense of space in the garden.
