

Clark is a scientist at the University of Texas. She studies noises and ears. Sound cannot the seen, but it can make the hair cells move back and forward. Think of the wind in the leaves.

Loud noises can damage(损伤) these cells. And once the cells are damaged, they don't grow bac k. Sometimes, there's tinnitus. 


