You can test whether a plant knows which way is up and which way is down. The test caught many children's eyes last week.

You'll need

Two large fresh carrots

Toothpicks( 牙签)

A large glass

· A small bowl

· A small sharp knife

Tweezers( 镊子)

An adult helper

Three steps

①Cut one carrot 2 cm from its large end. Cut the other carrot 5 cm

from its large end. Ask the helper to hollow( 挖空)it out with a knife and tweezers.

②Use toothpicks to fix the carrots. Stick( 戳)toothpicks in the small

carrot top and sit it over a bowl with the cut end in water. Stick

the hollow center.

For two weeks, keep water in the bowl so it touches the small carrot top; also keep the large carrot top's hollow center filled with water.

What will happen

Both carrots should grow leaves and stems( ).

Instead of growing downwards, the leaves on the larger carrot will turn and grow upwards.

Last year, I moved from London to the African grasslands because

my husband Robin took a new job there. Robin was able to work,

learned about many kinds of local birds.

One morning in September, after a bad rainstorm, I found a baby

bird on the ground outside of our home. His eyes were closed and

he was shaking. The poor little thing had been left behind by his

I placed him in a cardboard box. I stayed up all night that day to

study how to care for him.

The next day, he woke with his mouth wide-open with a sharp

hunger call. I fed him termites(白蚁)and chirped(叽喳叫)at him. He

chirped back, jumped into my hand and then fell asleep in my

hand. To him, I was mama bird.

For the 84 days, the cute little thing lived on me. Wherever I went,

he would fly alongside me. He would make short flights from my

hand to my head and then slide down my long hair to rest again. I

never named him because he didn't belong to me — I had to tell

Day by day, he was stronger, more confident and flying farther from me. His flock had returned to the grasslands. ③

Before I flew back to England in November for the holiday season, Robin and I had decided that he should be allowed outside to fly daily. Robin took him out to the flock three times. On the fourth day, the bird flew away with them. ④

When I returned, in January, I would watch out for him whenever birds flew past. Every one seemed to be him but no one was him. I would still cry when I thought of him. I wrote our story into a book, Fledgling. That, along with the lesson that any tiny animal can make a difference, will make me remember him forever.
