

Points to Remember:

Timing: Write the letter at the proper time. It is not advisable to put it off for too long.


Words: While you are writing the letter, what matters most is that you truly feel sorry.

Order: Always begin by saying sorry for your mistake. Then explain to him/her your side of the story. In the third and last paragraph, talk about what the friendship means to you and make a promise of not repeating the mistake.

Delivery: You should either post the letter or deliver it personally or through someone else. You can also keep it at a place where your friend will be able to find it easily. **Attention:** Some people may try to point out the friend's mistake while writing the letter. Avoid this completely, as it can make matters worse. Keep patient and do not expect immediate results. It may take time for the person to forgive(原谅) and forget.
