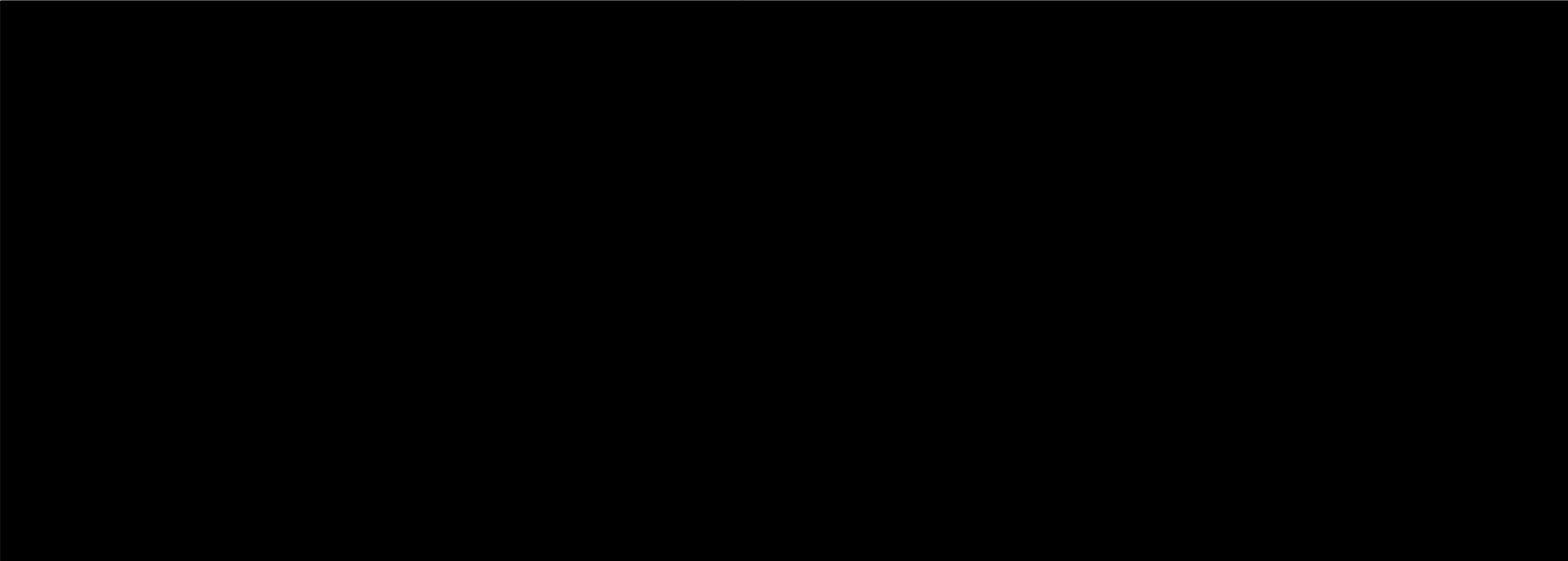

Countries with the highest infant mortality rate 2024

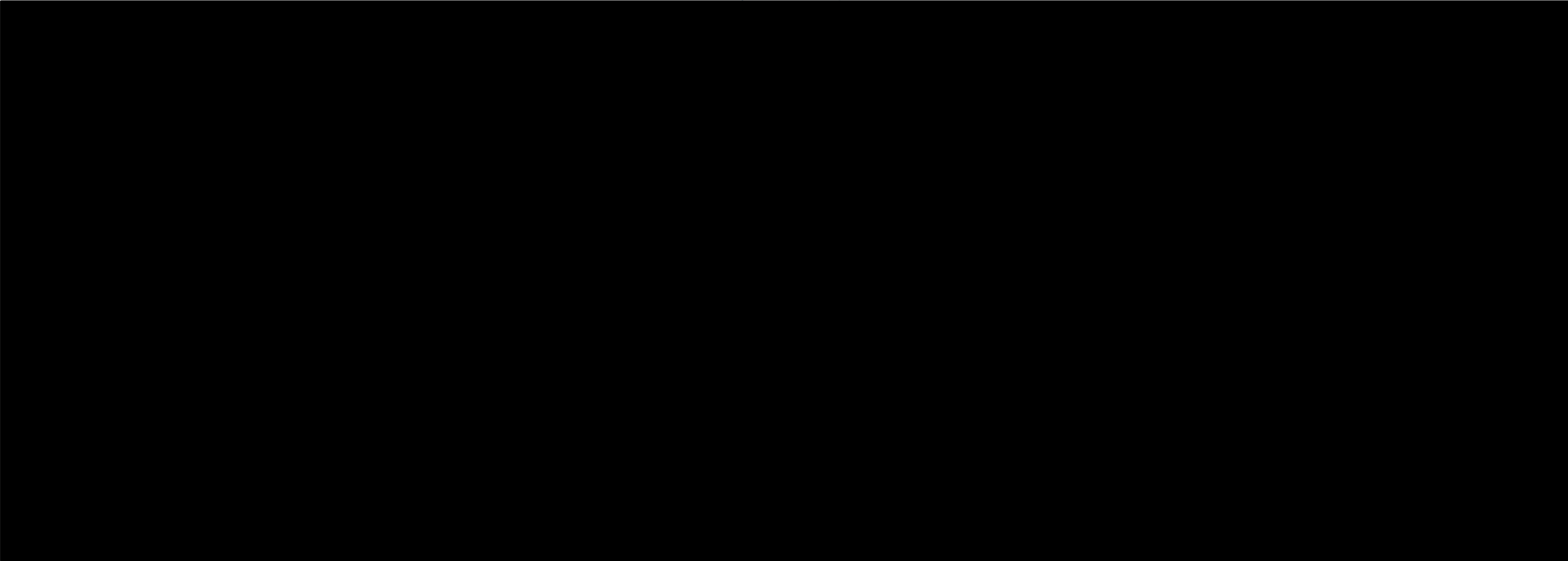
Child deaths in the first year of life per 1,000 live births



Ranking of the 20 countries* with the lowest infant mortality rate in 2024 (child deaths in the first year of life per 1,000 live births)

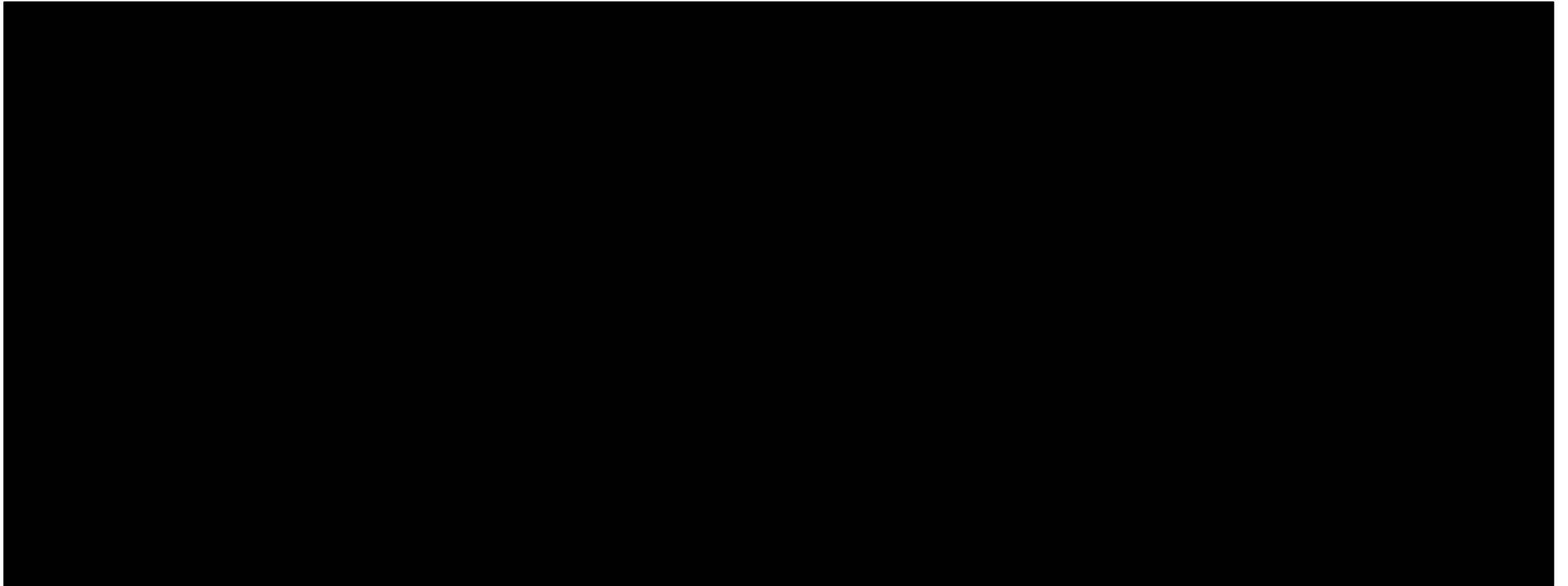

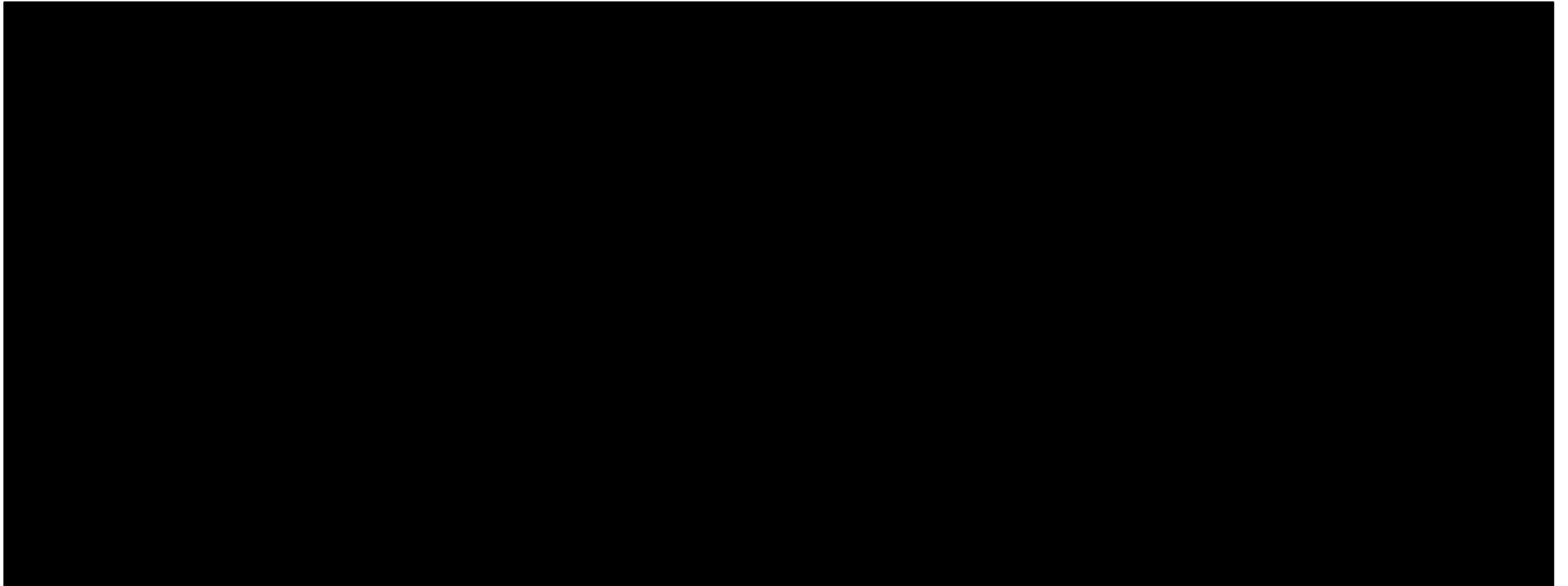

Number of infant deaths in the United States from 1995 to 2022

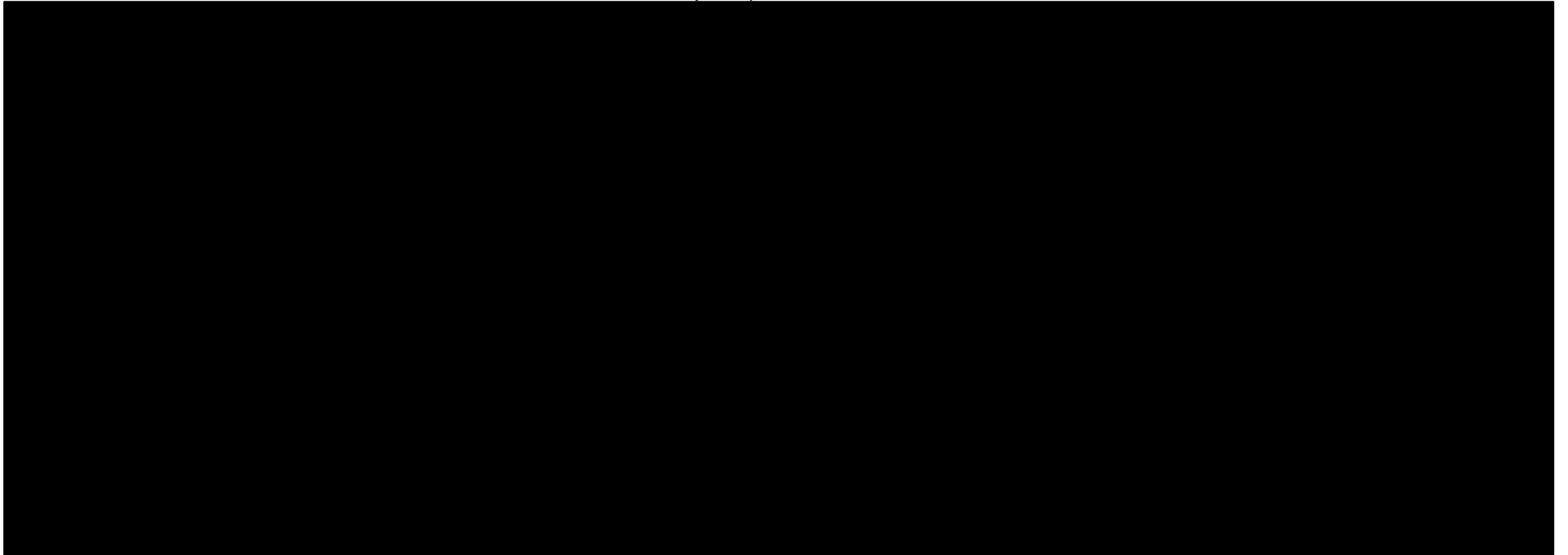
Number of infant deaths in the U.S. from 1995 to 2022



Infant mortality rate in the United States from 1960 to 2022 (per 1,000 live births)

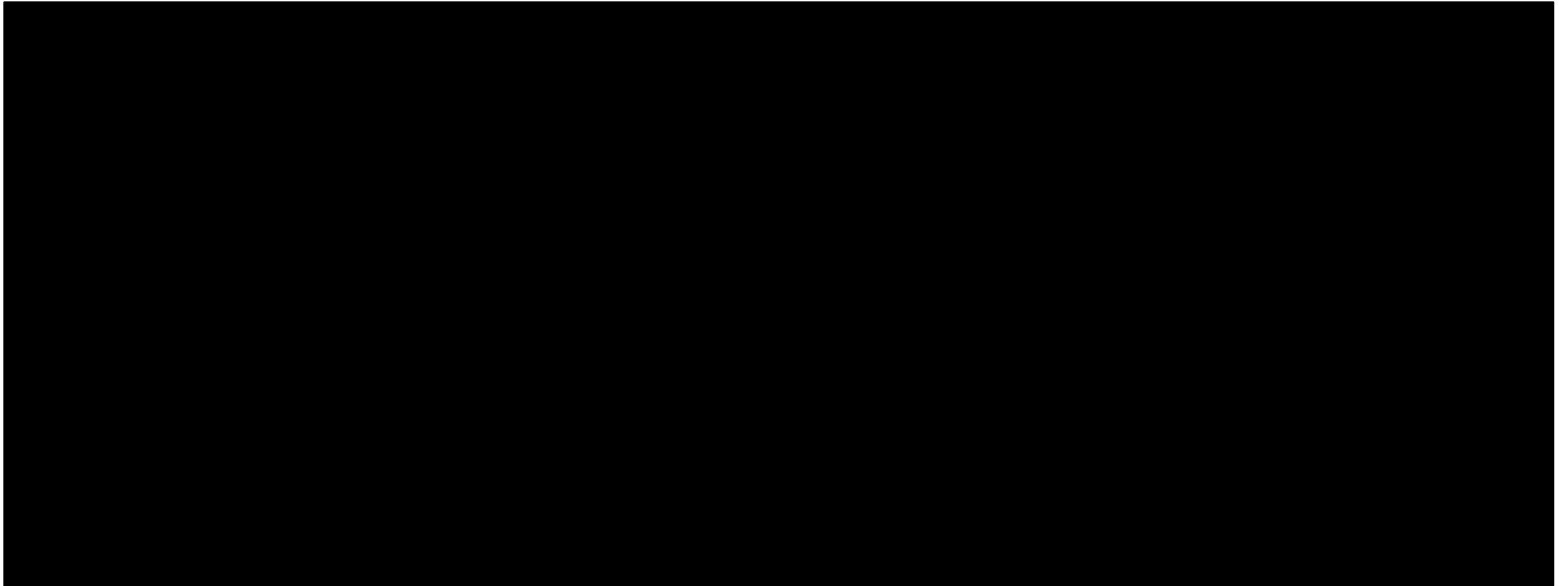
U.S. - Infant mortality rate 1960-2022

Infant mortality rate in the United States in 2021 and 2022, by race and ethnicity of mother

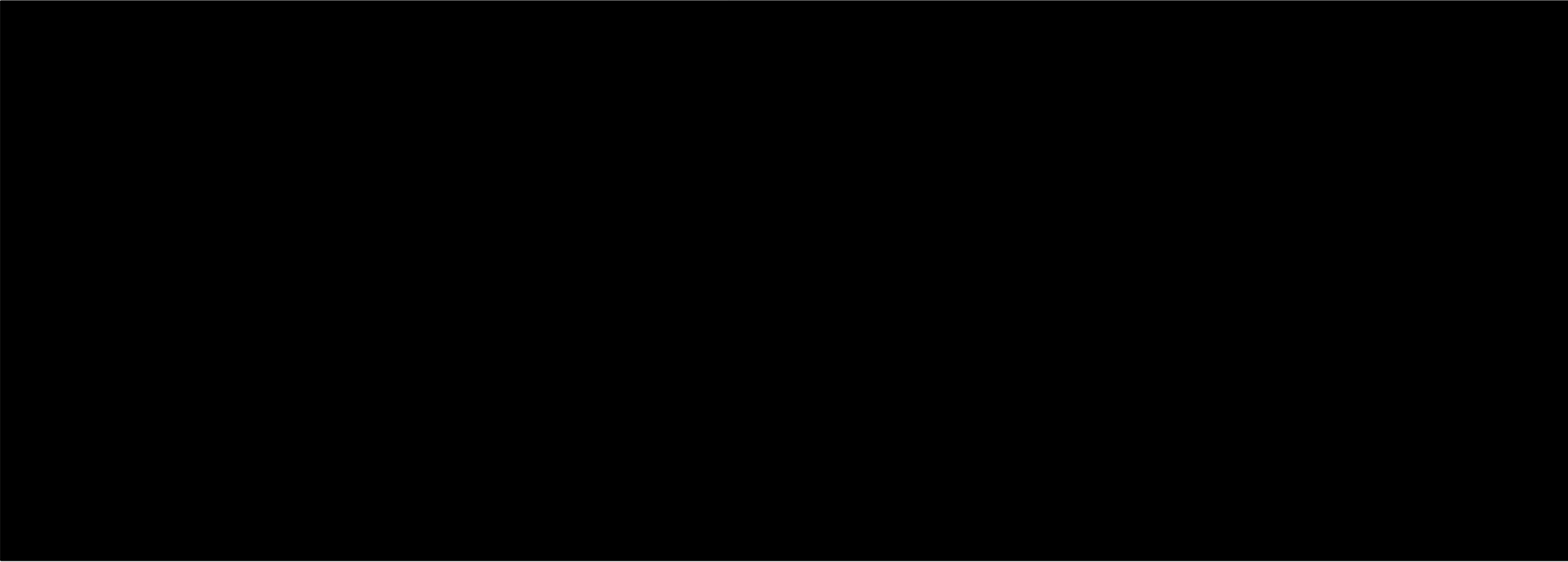
Infant mortality rate in the U.S. in 2021 and 2022, by maternal race and ethnicity

Deaths per 1,000 live births

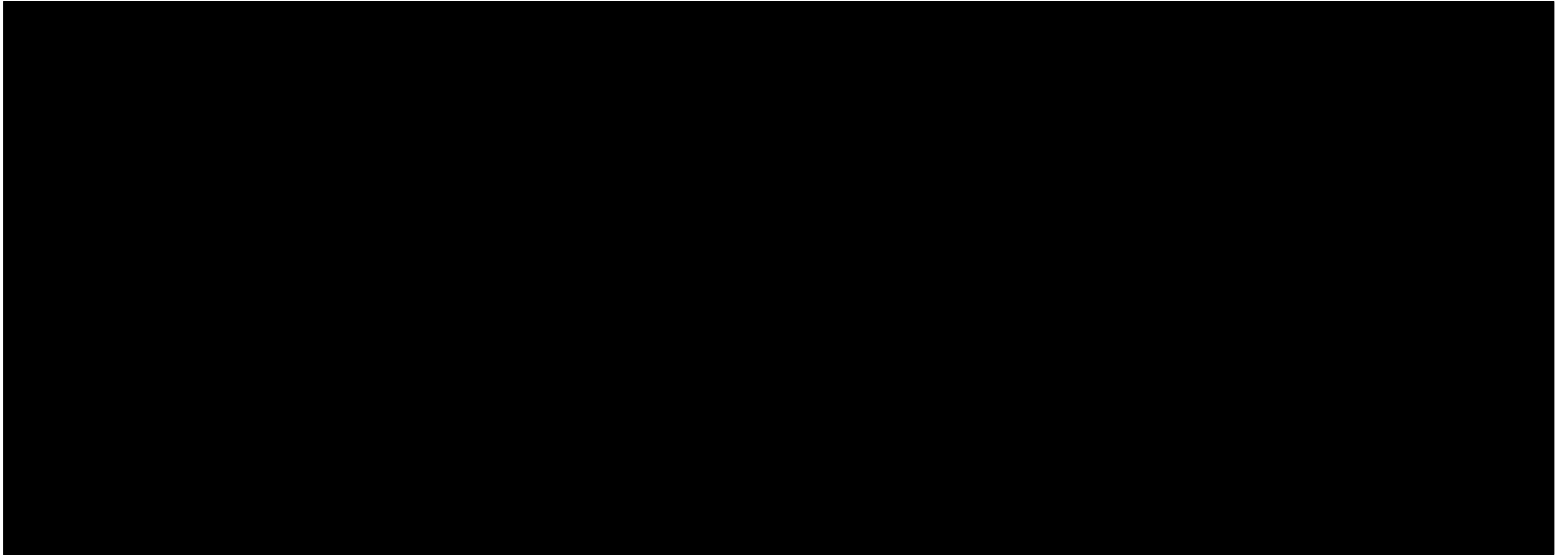

Number of U.S. neonatal and postneonatal deaths from 1995 to 2022

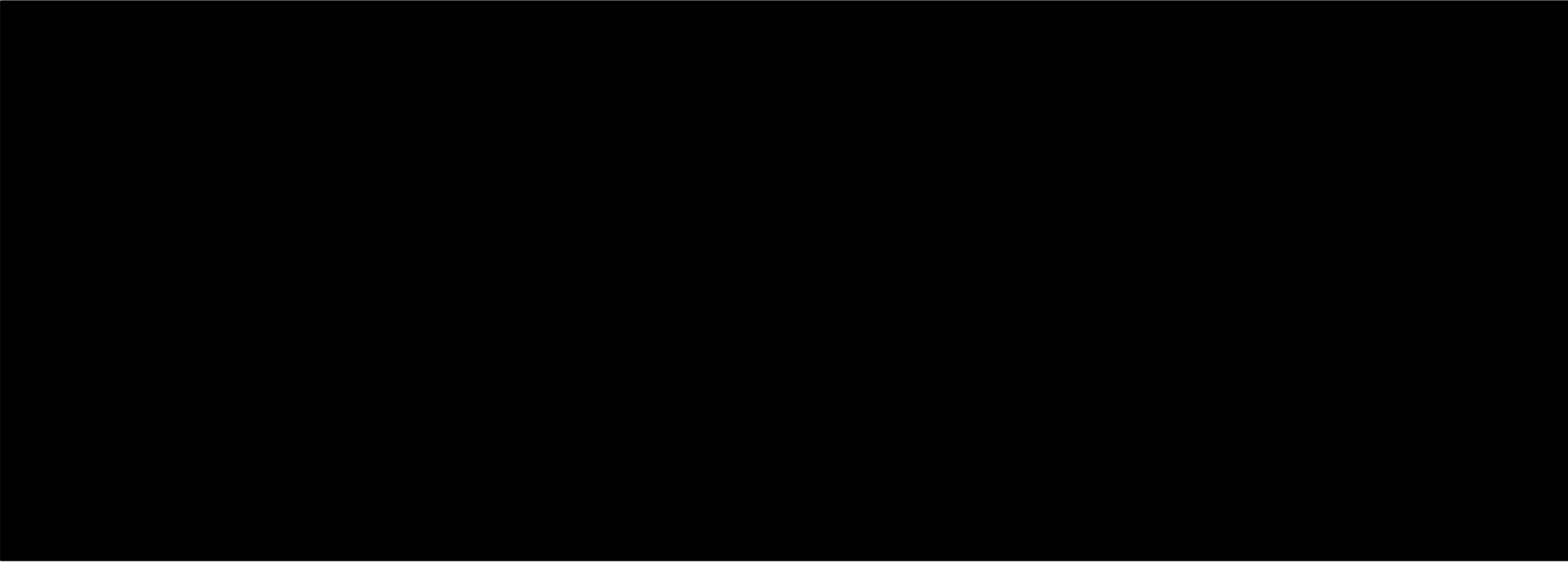

U.S. neonatal and postneonatal mortality rates from 1995 to 2022

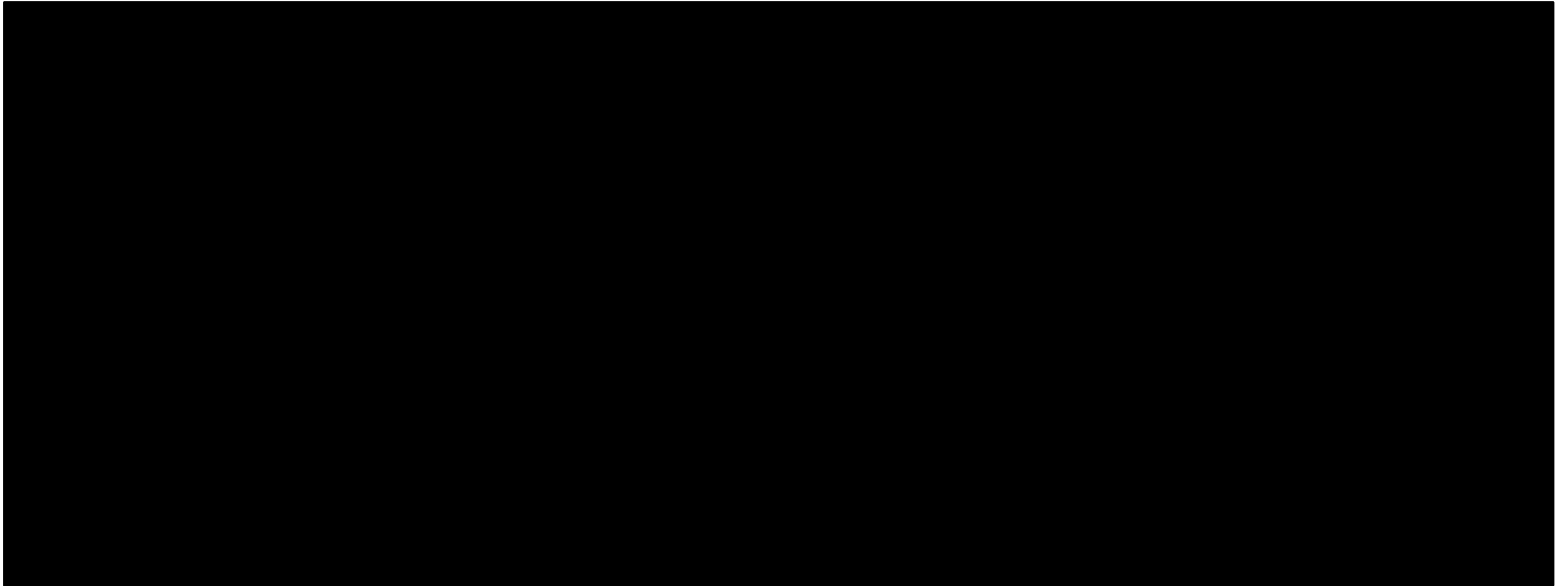
Deaths per 1,000 live births

U.S. neonatal and postneonatal mortality rates in 2022, by race/ethnicity



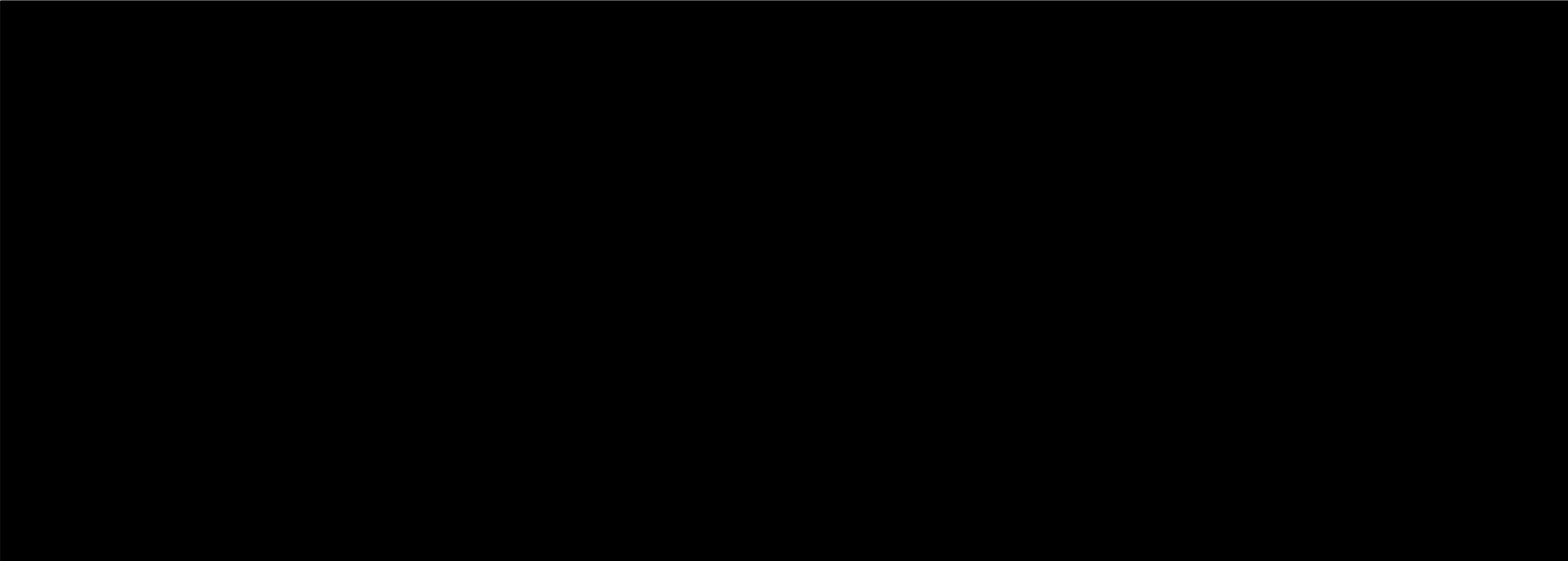

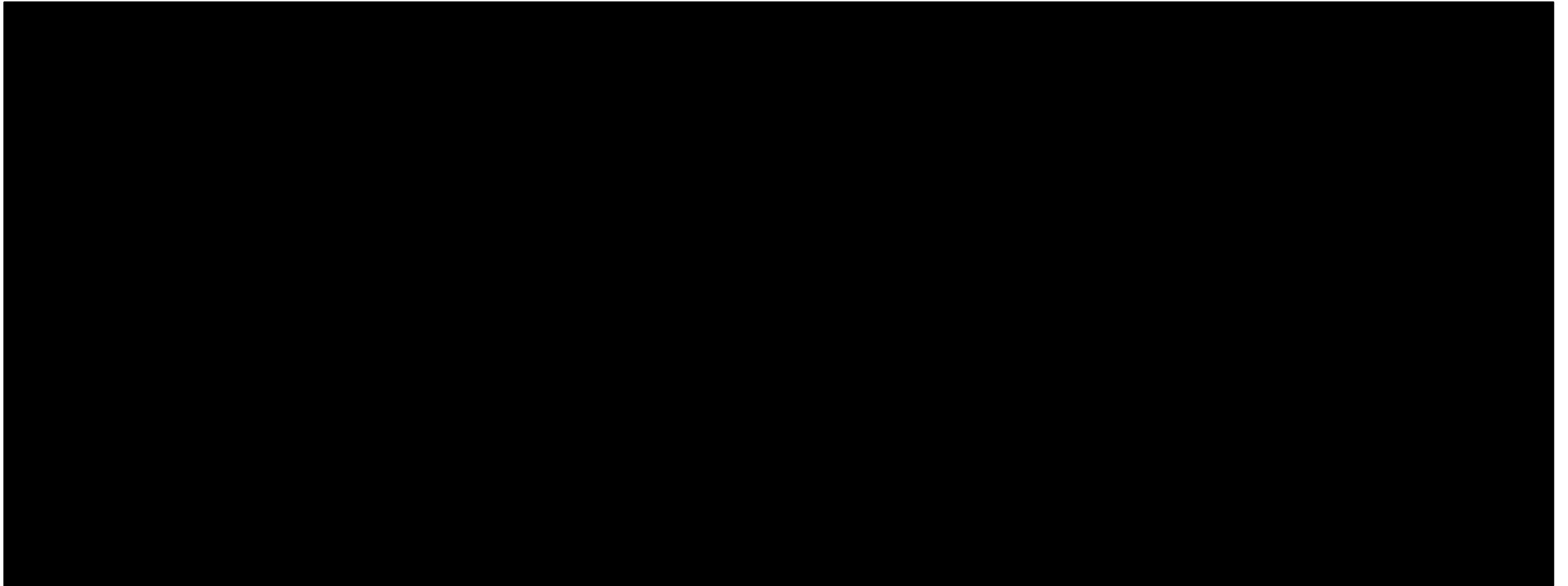

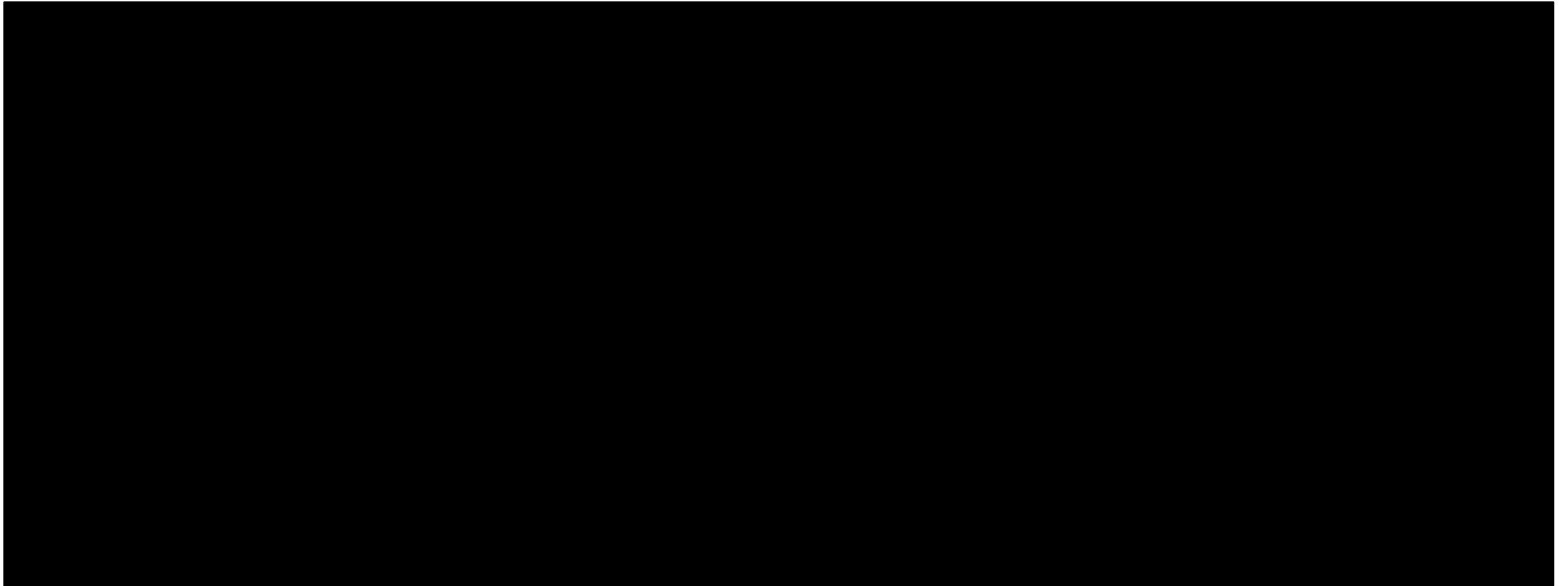
Fetal mortality rates in the United States from 1990 to 2022 (per 1,000 births)

Fetal mortality rates in the United States from 1990 to 2022



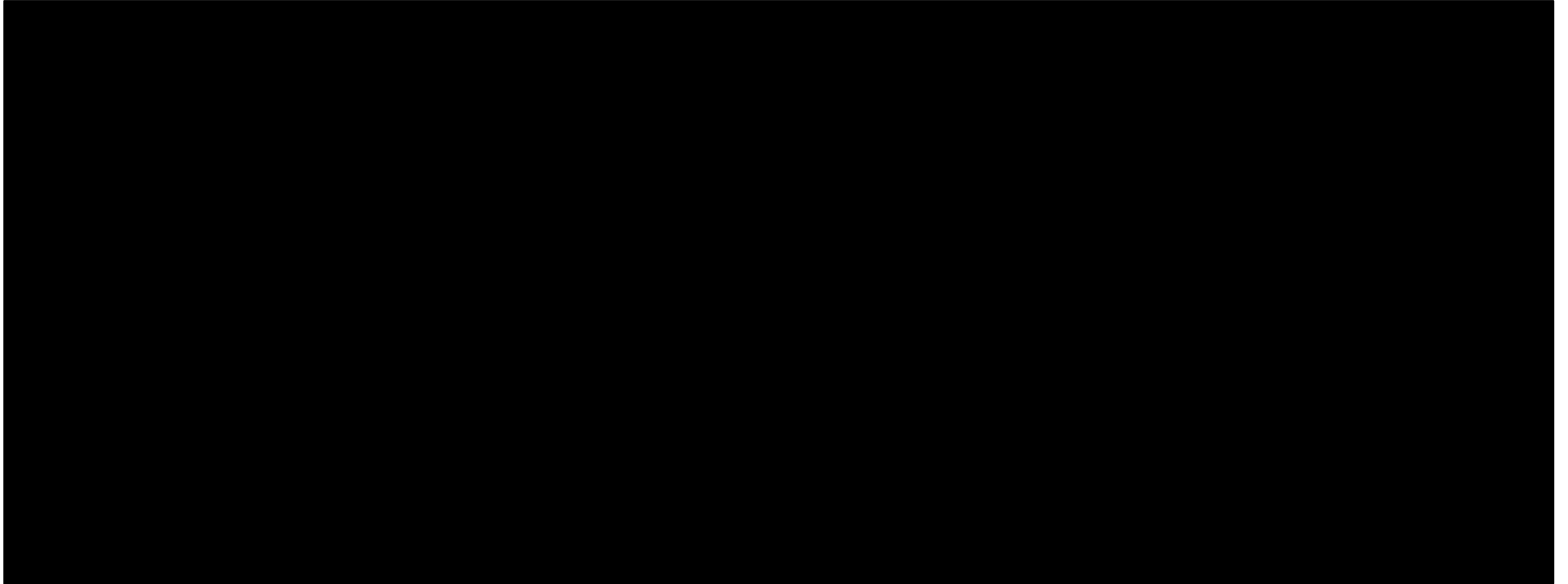
Fetal mortality rates in the United States in 2022, by age (per 1,000 births)
