1 In December 1938, a friend asked Winton to come to Prague to **aid** people who were escaping from the Nazis. (教材P20) 1938年12月, 一个朋友请求温顿来布拉格, 帮助那些正在逃离纳粹抓捕的人。

◆ aid *v.* 帮助, 援助 *n.* 援助, 救护, 辅助工具

The moment he saw the poor girl on TV, he determined to **aid** her in continuing her study.

他在电视上一看到这个可怜的女孩, 就决定要帮助她继续学业。

【词汇拓展】

give sb first aid/give first aid to sb 对某人进行急救

come/go to one's aid/help 帮助某人

in aid of 为了援助

with the aid of 在.....的帮助下

aid sb in (doing)/with sth 在(做)某事方面帮助某人

aid sb to do sth 帮助某人做某事

I didn' t speak any French, but a nice man **came to my aid** and told me where to go.

我不会说法语, 不过一个好心人帮了我的忙, 告诉我去哪里。

We are collecting money **in aid of** the people who have lost their homes.

我们正在筹集资金来帮助失去家园的灾民。

With the aid of our teacher, we finished the experiment successfully.

在我们老师的帮助下, 我们成功地完成了这个实验。

She **rose to her feet** and walked toward me.

她站起身,向我走来。
