expect 的用法

expect+ 名词/代词, 意为“期待某事(物)或某人; 预计……可能发生”。

expect (sb.) to do sth. 意为“预计/期望(某人)做某事”。

expect+that 从句, 意为“预计……”。

用法	例句
decide to do sth. =make a decision to do sth. 决定做某事。	We decided to start early. 我们决定早点开始。
decide+宾语从句, 意为“决定……”。	I decide that I will go to Shanghai this summer. 我决定今年夏天去上海。
